1. Load passengers in front of 1 Aviation Circle
2. Drive Garages/Rental Car Route
3. Drive to Garage A
  - Fun facts:
    - Airport opened June 16, 1941
    - Terminal A is on the National Register of Historic Places (1987)
    - Terminal B/C opened in 1997, was designed by Cesar Pelli
    - 860 acres, 44 gates
    - 18.7 million passengers (2007)
4. Garage A
  - Currently 246 parking spaces on level 1- 1 entry, 1 exit (Level 4 closed, 575 spaces)
  - Rental cars on 2 and 3
  - Level 5 construction scheduled for completion mid-January 2010, adding 581 spaces, 2 additional entry and exit lanes.
5. Garage B/C
  - Approximately 455 hourly and 3,869 daily public parking spaces
  - 2 hourly and 6 daily entry lanes, 9 exit lanes
  - Construction adding a level, approximately 843 new public parking spaces.
6. Loop through Economy
  - Approximately 2,956 public parking spaces
  - 2 entry and 2 exit lanes
7. Drive to Bus Maintenance Facility
  - 8,000 sq. ft., 2 maint. bays, 2 fuel islands, office space
8. Drive back to 1 Aviation Circle
