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## Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority Financial Statements May 2013 Aviation Enterprise Fund – Highlights in Brief

- ★ Total operating revenues for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for May 2013 were \$60.2 million. Operating revenues increased from April 2013 by \$0.6 million mostly due to increases in rents of \$1.2 million, concessions of \$0.9 million and passenger conveyance fees of \$0.1 million offset by decreases in international arrival fees of \$0.8 million, landing fees of \$0.5 million and utility sales of \$0.2 million. The decrease in landing fees of \$0.5 million resulted from the impact of the 2012 settlement of \$1.1 million.
- Year-to-date operating revenues through May 2013 were \$296.0 million, which is an increase of \$17.5 million over 2012 totals. Rent revenue increases of \$8.9 million, landing fees of \$3.6 million, passenger conveyance fees of \$0.4 million and international arrival fees of \$0.3 million were higher primarily due to higher rates. In addition to the rate increases, concessions were higher by \$3.7 million, utility sales by \$0.5 million, and other revenues by \$0.2 million.
- → Total operating expenses for the Aviation Enterprise Fund during the month of May 2013 were \$50.1 million, which is \$0.5 million higher than for April 2013 mostly due to increases in services of \$2.1 million, materials and supplies of \$1.0 million, and insurance of \$0.1 million offset by decreases in depreciation and amortization of \$1.0 million, utilities of \$0.9 million and salaries and related benefits of \$0.8 million.
- Year-to-date operating expenses through May 2013 were \$247.5 million, which is higher than 2012 by \$2.8 million primarily due to increases in services of \$2.2 million, salaries and related benefits of \$1.6 million, insurance of \$0.5 million, depreciation and amortization of \$0.2 million, and telecommunication of \$0.1 million, offset by project expenses of \$1.6 million, utilities of \$0.2 million, and travel of \$0.2 million.
- ✤ Operating income for the Aviation Enterprise Fund in May 2013 was \$10.1 million compared to operating income of \$10.0 million in April 2013.
- → Year-to-date through May 2013, operating income was \$48.5 million compared to the operating income of \$33.8 million through May 2012.
- → Net non-operating income in May 2013 was \$13.5 million compared to net non-operating expenses in April 2013 of \$27.9 million. This is an increase in net non-

operating income of about \$41.4 million primarily due to a \$42.4 million increase in the change in the swaps fair value, an increase in investment losses of \$0.6 million, an increase in interest expense of \$0.3 million and a \$0.1 million decrease in federal, state and local grants.

- → Through May 2013, year-to-date net non-operating expenses were \$47.1 million compared to net non-operating expenses of \$101.1 million in 2012. The positive difference of \$54.0 million is mostly comprised of a \$54.5 million positive difference in the change in the swaps fair value, a reduction in interest expense of \$0.7 million and an increase in grants of \$0.6 million offset by a decrease in investment losses of \$1.8 million.
- ★ The capital contributions for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of May 2013 were \$26.3 million compared to \$9.3 million in April 2013. The \$17.0 million increase is due to increases of \$14.4 million in federal, state and local grants and \$2.6 million in passenger facility charges. Year-to-date capital contributions were \$64.7 million, up by \$20.7 million from 2012, due to an increase of \$21.7 million in grants offset by a decrease of \$0.9 million in passenger facility charges.
- ★ There is an increase in net position for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of May 2013 of \$49.9 million as compared to a decrease in net position for the prior month of \$8.6 million.
- The year-to-date increase in net position through May 2013 was \$66.1 million, compared to a year-to-date decrease in net position of \$23.3 million through May 2012.
- Accounts receivables delinquent over 30 days, including amounts past due which are in bankruptcy proceedings, had a balance of \$1.8 million as of May 31, 2013 and April 30, 2013. Delinquent accounts receivables for customer accounts which have a net credit balance are excluded from reported delinquent receivables.
- → Debt service coverage remained the same at 1.35x in May 2013 and April 2013.

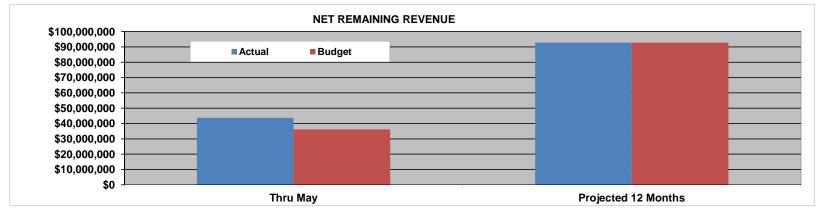

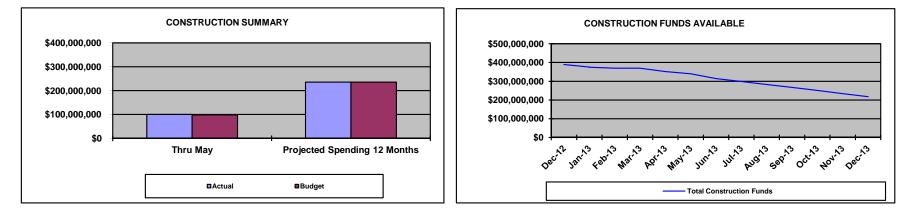

The year-to-date construction spending is at \$100.3 million. The 2013 budget for Capital Construction Program expenditures totals \$235.9 million.

Short-Term Liquidity Forecast: As of May 31, 2013 the Authority had \$339.6 million available in construction funds, which includes \$250.0 million on the shelf in Commercial Paper Series 1 fund. Of the funds on hand as of the end of April, \$45.5 million were PFC and Grant recycled funds. PFC and Grant recycled funds are available for the same purpose as AMT bond funds. Included in the funds on hand as of May 31 were \$210 thousand of non-AMT bond funds, the majority of which is from the 2010A debt issuance.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during May include the following:

- The decrease in the Airlines delinquencies is primarily the result of a payment in the amount of \$124,677 from American Airlines. The most significant increase in delinquency is a Frontier Airlines landing fee invoice of \$85,409, minus a credit in the amount of \$51,666 for a net amount of \$33,743.
- The Non- Airlines decrease in delinquencies is attributed to a receipt from Marketplace in the amount of \$7,692. Marketplace has the largest delinquent balance which consists of a concession invoice in the amount of \$10,397. TGIF Joint Venture has the second largest delinquency balance which consists of utility billings in the amount of \$7,462.
- The largest delinquent balance for a Government agency is TSA which includes \$360,657 for public safety and rent invoices.
- For Telecommunications TSA represents the largest amount of the delinquency in the amount of \$11,315.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during the month of May include the following:

- The increase in Airline delinquencies is primarily due to American Airlines in the amount of \$150,558, Virgin American in the amount of \$131,416 and Emirates Airlines in the net amount of \$69,045 for landing fees, taxi script, rent and signatory passenger fees.
- The decrease in Non-Airline delinquencies is primarily due to receipt of payments from AMB/AFCO Cargo of \$172,552 and AECOMM Tech of \$24,910. Marketplace has the most significant delinquencies, with a balance as of May 31st of \$233, 369, with an increase of \$53,066 that occurred in May.
- The Government delinquencies decrease is attributed to the payment of \$15,587 from FAA. The largest delinquency for TSA is \$58,400 for public safety invoices.
- The Telecommunications increase is attributed to Cox Communications. Cox Communication has the largest delinquency as of May 31<sup>st</sup> totaling \$13,744.
