# Recommendation to the Business Administration Committee to Award Taxicab Concession Contracts at Washington Dulles International Airport

June 2013

### PURPOSE

Staff requests that the Business Administration Committee approve and recommend to the Board of Directors the award of three contracts with terms of three years with two one-year options, commencing October 1, 2013, to Checker Airport Taxi, Inc. (CAT) of Baltimore, MD; Dulles Airport Taxi, Inc. (DAT) of Falls Church, VA; and Regency Cab, Inc. (Regency) of Gaithersburg, MD to operate taxicab concessions at Dulles International.

# BACKGROUND

- Dulles International has three concessions contracts to provide inbound and outbound taxicab services.
- The taxicab concessions contracts were last competed in a Request for Proposals (RFP) in 2008. The incumbents are Checker Airport Taxi, Inc., Dulles Airport Taxi, Inc. and Dulles Taxi Systems, Inc.

- The three contracts have generated approximately \$15,672,000 over the contract term of three years and two one-year options.
- The Business Administration Committee reviewed and concurred with the RFP terms for a new solicitation which was issued in January 2013.

- Nine proposals were received and evaluated; three proposals were deemed outside the competitive range and eliminated from continuing in the process; CAT, DAT and Regency received three highest overall scores.
- The three contracts are expected to generate a combined estimated \$23,740,000 for the Airports Authority through the term of the contracts.
