Service utilizes the two DOT-awarded AIR-21 slots returned by Spirit Airlines in August 2012.

American/US Airways Merger Update



- → Plan to merge by Q3 2013 and integrate operations starting 2014 with unified service, marketing, customer experience and facilities' co-locations.
- Remaining approvals
 - ✓ DOJ is lead agency for federal approvals
 - Shareholder approval required for deal closing

Largest Impact of AA/US Merger on Washington Airport System is at Reagan National

- → AA/US combined has 68% of daily departures and over 60% of seats serving 77 markets at DCA.
- → Two markets are served by both AA and US at DCA:
 - Nashville
 - ✓ Raleigh/Durham
- → Analysts have suggested that AA/US slot concentration at DCA may result in required slot divestiture.



- Await DOJ decision
- Work with American Airlines and US Airways to accommodate operational and facility requests
- Staff continue to keep Board informed

New Air Service Developments at Dulles



Etihad – Daily Dulles/Abu Dhabi, UAE – began March 31 - *Increased aircraft size to A340-600 (+50 seats per flight) – June 1*



Brussels Airlines – Dulles/Brussels, Belgium (5x per week) – *Starts June 18*



Air Cargo Industry

- Leading analysts predict air cargo industry to remain stagnant.
- Air Cargo is highly dependent on global economy.
- Perishable air cargo shows strong growth potential.
- Most Dulles international airlines are showing cargo losses across the board.
- Middle Eastern carriers are the exception with double digit cargo growth.
