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

### **Airports Authority System**

• Combined, passenger activity declined 5.6% and operations fell 7.8% in February 2014 primarily as a result of poor weather conditions. The chart below depicts the daily percentage change in operations from 2013 for the combined system. The effects of the inclement weather are most apparent on February 13, when 5.9 inches of snow fell on Reagan National and 11.7 inches fell on Dulles International, resulting in an 89% reduction in total operations for the day. For the month of February, Reagan recorded 11.2 inches of snowfall and Dulles recorded 16.3 inches.



### **Change in Operations from February 2013**

### **Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport**

• Domestic passenger activity declined 3.5% and commercial operations fell 7.1% in February as a result of snowfall and other poor weather conditions during the month. Total passenger traffic at Reagan National exceeded Dulles passenger volume for the first time since February 2013. Significant activity by carrier follows:

- Transborder passenger traffic declined 7.5% while commercial operations fell 11.1% as a result of poor weather and service reductions to Montreal, Nassau, and Toronto by US Airways.
- US Airways, including its regional affiliates, had the largest commercial passenger market share with 46.5%, a decrease compared to 47.3% in February 2013.

### Washington Dulles International Airport

#### **Domestic Passenger Activity**

• Weather-related cancellations resulted in a 9.9% decline in domestic commercial passenger activity and a 9.7% decline in operations compared to February 2013. Significant domestic activity by carrier follows:

### International Passenger Activity

• February 2014 international commercial passenger traffic declined 2.2% and operations declined 5.9% compared to a year ago. Significant activity by carrier follows:

• United Airlines, including its regional affiliates, had the largest commercial passenger market share of 68.5%, a decrease compared to 70.2% in February 2013.

### Cargo Activity

- For the month of February, total cargo increased 2.0% from 2013. Domestic cargo declined 15.8% mainly due to a 17.1% decline in Dulles's largest domestic cargo carrier, FedEx, resulting from reductions in inbound freight as heavier shipments were shifted to ground service. FedEx activity at BWI declined 14.5%. Moreover, domestic cargo on United declined 21.6% as United has shifted to narrow-body aircraft.
- International cargo increased 13.3% due to increases on British Airways (40.2%) and United (4.8%), as well as Etihad and Brussels Airlines, both of which began operations in the past 12 months.

### **Baltimore-Washington International Airport**

- Current month commercial passenger activity vs. February 2013 decreased 7.0%.
- BWI surpassed Dulles by 60.6k commercial passengers (4.7%), but National's commercial passenger traffic exceeded BWI's by 26.5K passengers (2.0%). International passenger volume increased 13.7% to 56.0K compared to 49.3K in February 2013.
- Southwest had the largest passenger market share with 71.0%, compared to 70.9% in February 2013.
- Cargo activity totaled 7.7k metric tonnes, a 9.1% decline from a year earlier.
