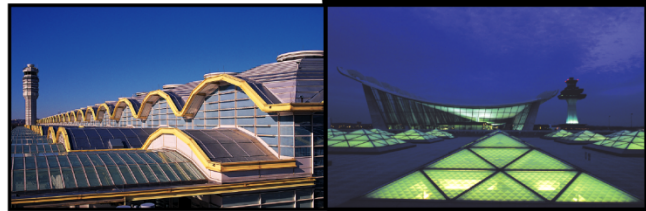

Airports Authority System

- Combined passenger activity across both airports declined 3.6% and commercial operations fell 3.8% in March 2014 primarily as a result of winter weather.
- At Reagan National, 12.7 inches of snow fell during March 2014, compared to 1.6 inches in March 2013.
- At Dulles International, 19.8 inches of snow fell during March 2014, compared to 7.4 inches in March 2013.

Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport

- Domestic passenger activity declined 4.9% and commercial operations fell 4.1% in March as a result of snowfall during the month. Significant activity by carrier follows:

- Transborder passenger traffic declined 6.7% while commercial operations fell 13.0% as a result of winter weather and service reductions to Montreal and Toronto by US Airways.
- US Airways, including its regional affiliates, had the largest commercial passenger market share with 44.9%, a decrease compared to 45.5% in March 2013.

Washington Dulles International Airport

Domestic Passenger Activity

- Weather-related flight cancellations resulted in a 2.7% decline in domestic commercial passenger activity and a 5.0% decline in operations compared to March 2013. Significant domestic activity by carrier follows:

International Passenger Activity

- March 2014 international commercial passenger traffic declined 1.1% and operations increased 4.0% compared to a year ago. Significant activity by carrier follows:

- United Airlines, including its regional affiliates, had the largest commercial passenger market share of 68.0%, a decrease compared to 68.4% in March 2013.

Cargo Activity

- For the month of March, total cargo increased 4.7% from 2013. Domestic cargo declined 18.7% mainly due to a 20.7% decline in Dulles's largest domestic cargo carrier, FedEx, resulting from reductions in inbound freight as heavier shipments were shifted to ground service. FedEx activity at BWI declined 15.9%. Moreover, domestic cargo on United declined 18.1%. As with passenger activity, cargo levels were negatively impacted by the winter weather.
- International cargo increased 19.5% due to increases on United (14.6%), British Airways (40.2%), All Nippon (9.7%), and KLM (39.0%), as well as Etihad and Brussels Airlines, both of which began operations in the past 12 months.

Baltimore-Washington International Airport

- Current month commercial passenger activity vs. March 2013 decreased 4.2%.
- BWI passenger activity outpaced activity at Dulles by 73.0k commercial passengers (4.1%) and activity at National by 137.1k passengers (8.1%). International passenger volume increased 14.0% to 74.5k compared to 65.3k in March 2013.
- Southwest had the largest passenger market share with 71.8%, compared to 72.2% in March 2013.
- Cargo activity totaled 8.3k metric tonnes, a 9.7% decline from a year earlier.

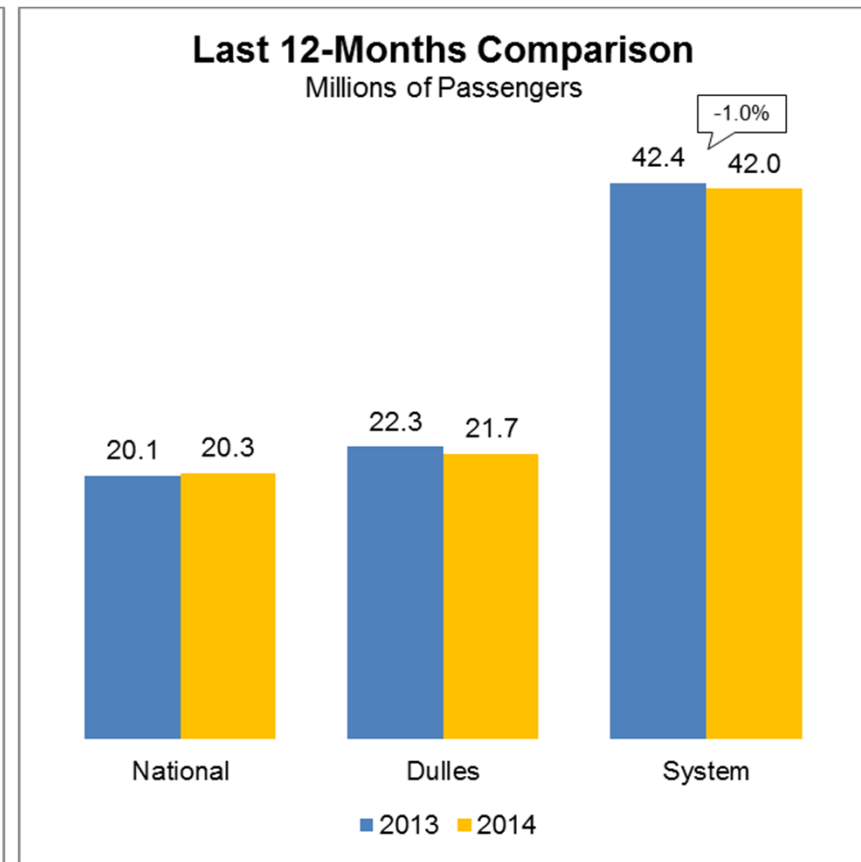
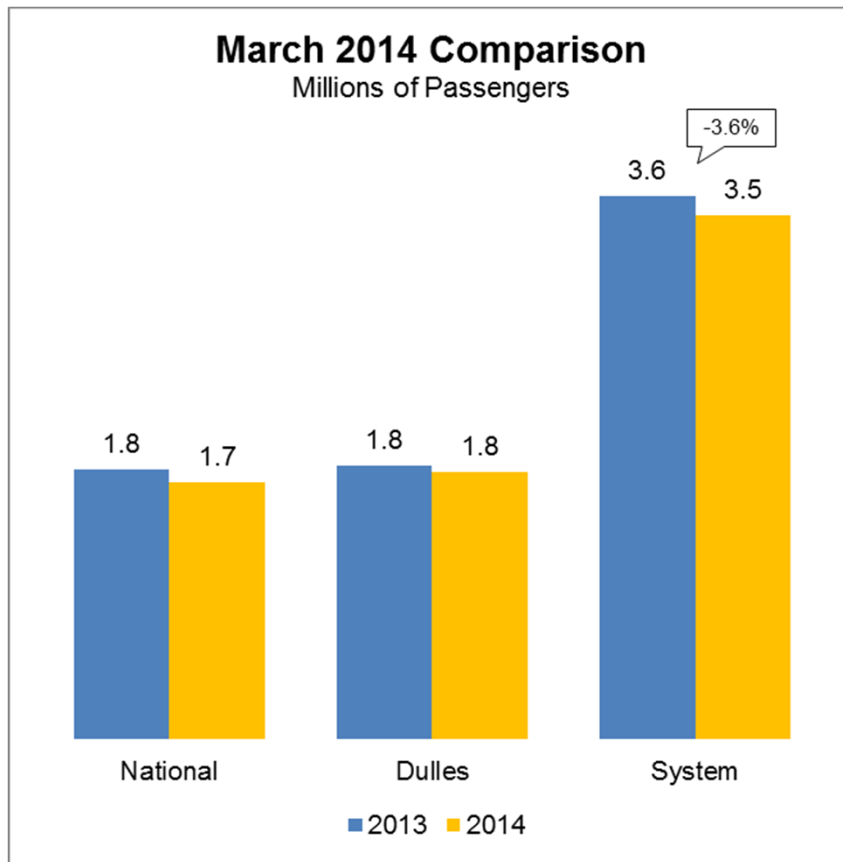

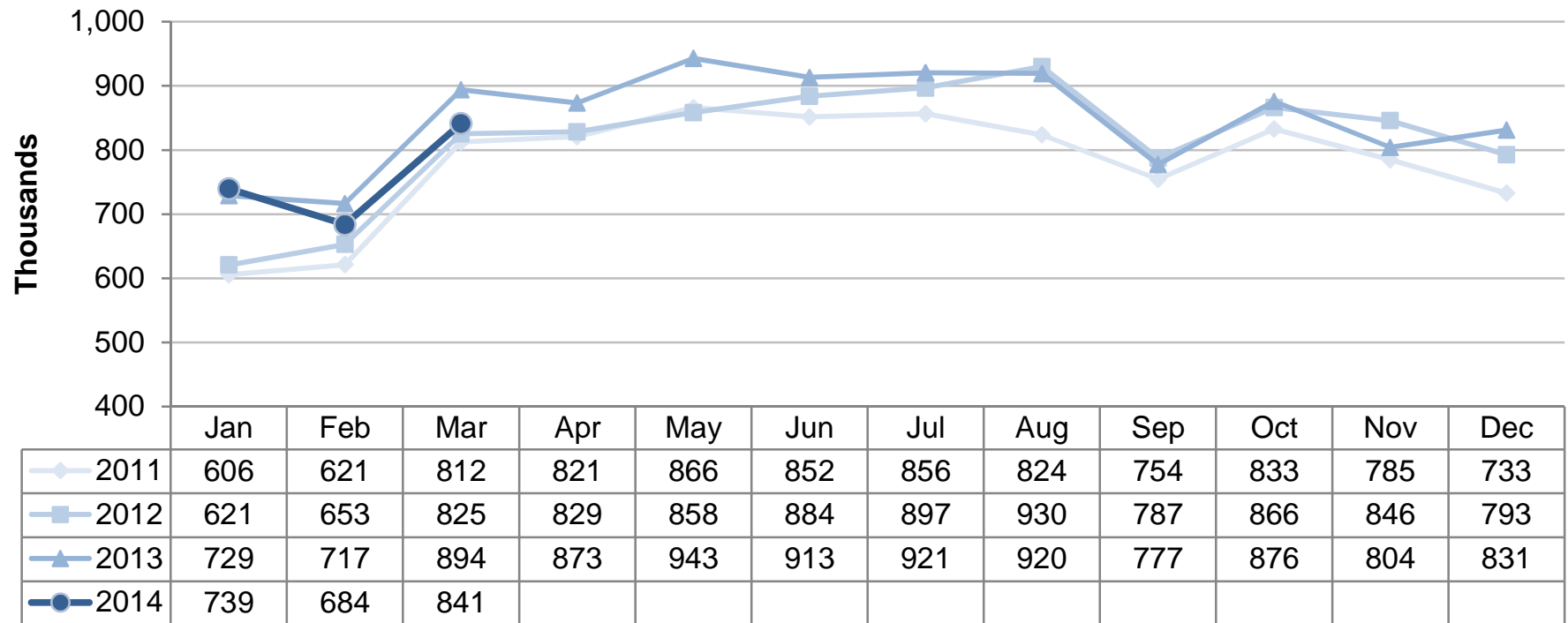

Total Passengers Four Year Comparison of the Month of March (Thousands)

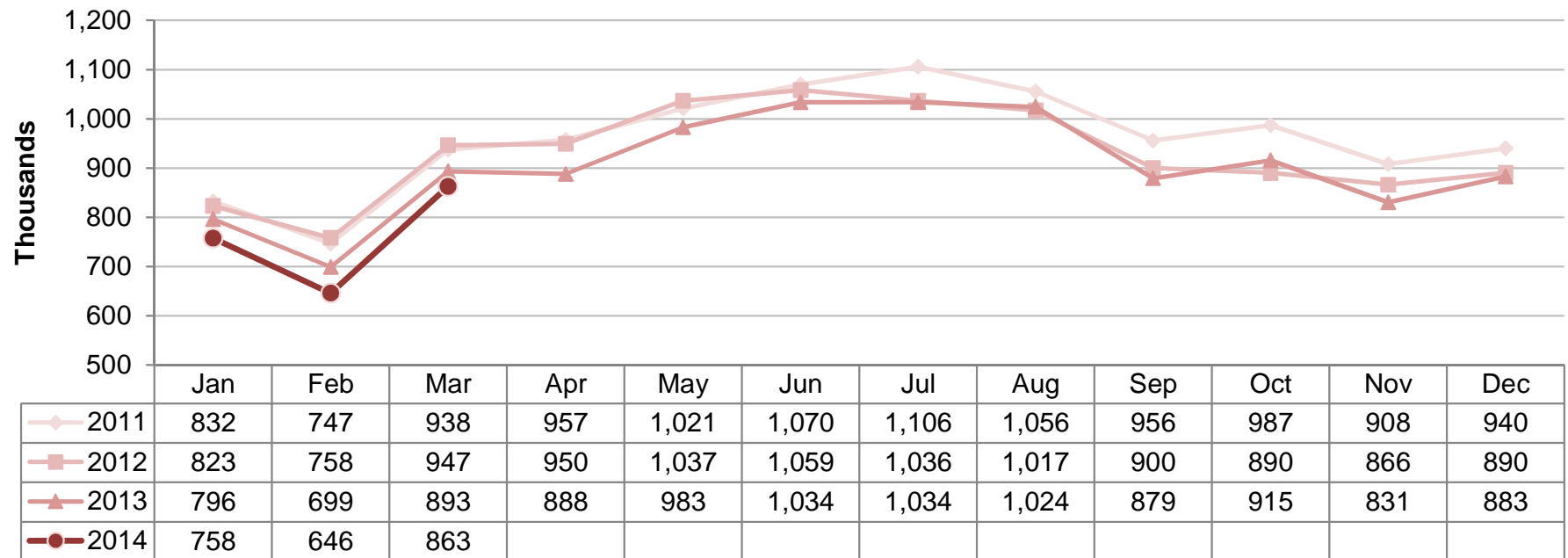
