## **Blasting Permit**

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Copies of blasting records shall be submitted to the Fire Code Enforcement Division no later than 48 hours after blasting.
- A separate permit is required for storage of any explosive, ammunition or blasting agent on MWAA property.
- 3. All vehicles transporting explosives and/or blasting agents shall comply with the requirements of BATF Rule #77-24 as listed in 27 CFR 55.213.
- 4. The Fire/Rescue Department Emergency Communications Center shall be notified at least ten (10) minutes prior to any blast. (703) 572-2100
- 5. Blasting contractors shall comply with all Federal, State, and Local Laws, ordinances and regulations inluding the MWAA Construction Safety Manual.
- 6. All blasting shall occur between sunrise and sunset ONLY.
- 7. Where required, copies of sesmographic reports shall be submitted to the Fire Code Enforcement Division no later than 48 hours after blasting.
- Failure to comply with the requirements of the Blasting Permit or any Federal, State or Local Law, ordinance and/or regulation will result in the issuance of a summons and the blasting operation will be stopped.
