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Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority Financial Statements July 2014 Aviation Enterprise Fund – Highlights in Brief

- Total operating revenues for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for July 2014 were \$61.0 million. Operating revenues decreased from June 2014 by \$0.4 million mostly due to decreases in concessions of \$0.4 million, rents of \$0.3 million and security fees of \$0.1 million offset by increases in international arrival fees of \$0.3 million, and other revenues of \$0.1 million.
- Year-to-date operating revenues through July 2014 were \$414.8 million, which is a decrease of \$5.3 million below 2013 totals. Rents decreased by \$6.6 million, landing fees decreased by \$6.0 million and international arrival fees decreased by 0.9 million. The decreases are offset by increases in concessions of \$6.0 million, security fees of \$0.8 million, passenger conveyance fees of \$0.5 million, utility sales of \$0.5 million and other revenues of \$0.4 million.
- Total operating expenses for the Aviation Enterprise Fund during the month of July 2014 were \$53.2 million, which is \$2.3 million higher than for June 2014 mostly due to increases in services of \$2.2 million, utilities of \$0.6 million, and materials and supplies of \$0.3 million offset by decreases in projects expenses of \$0.3 million, salaries and related benefits of \$0.3 million and depreciation and amortization of \$0.2 million.
- Year-to-date operating expenses through July 2014 were \$359.8 million, which is \$10.3 million higher than 2013 primarily due to increases in services of \$7.5 million, salaries and related benefits of \$2.0 million, materials and supplies of \$1.7 million project expenses of \$1.3 million and telecommunications of \$0.2 million, offset by decreases in depreciation and amortization of \$2.1 million, travel of \$0.1 million, lease from the U.S. government of \$0.1 million and non-cash gains of \$0.1 million.
- → Operating income for the Aviation Enterprise Fund in July 2014 was \$7.8 million compared to operating income of \$10.5 million in June 2014.
- Year-to-date through July 2014, operating income was \$55.0 million compared to operating income of \$70.5 million through July 2013.

- → In July 2014 there was a net non-operating loss of \$15.2 million compared to a net non-operating loss in June 2014 of \$14.2 million. The decrease of \$1.0 million is primarily due to a \$0.5 million decrease in the swaps fair value, an increase in interest expense of \$0.3 million and lower investment gains of \$0.1 million.
- Through July 2014, year-to-date net non-operating expenses were \$140.3 million compared to net non-operating expenses of \$55.3 million in 2013. The decrease of \$85.0 million is primarily comprised of a \$89.6 million decrease in the change in the swaps fair value offset by a decrease in interest expense of \$2.5 million and an increase in investment gains of \$2.1 million.
- The capital contributions for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of July 2014 were \$9.6 million compared to \$9.8 million in June 2014. The \$0.2 million decrease is primarily due to a \$0.2 million decrease in grant revenue. Year-to-date capital contributions were \$86.6 million, an increase of \$2.0 million from 2013, due to increases of \$1.0 million in passenger facility charges and increases of \$1.0 million in grant revenue.
- There is an increase in net position for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of July 2014 of \$2.2 million compared to an increase of \$6.2 million for the prior month.
- The year-to-date increase in net position through July 2014 was \$1.2 million compared to a year-to-date increase of \$99.8 million through July 2013.
- Accounts receivables delinquent over 30 days, including amounts past due which are in bankruptcy proceedings, had a balance of \$1.7 million as of July 31, 2014, a increase of 11.3% from June 30, 2014. Delinquent accounts receivables for customer accounts which have a net credit balance are excluded from reported delinquent receivables.
- → Debt service coverage decreased from 1.41x in June 2014 to 1.39x in July 2014.

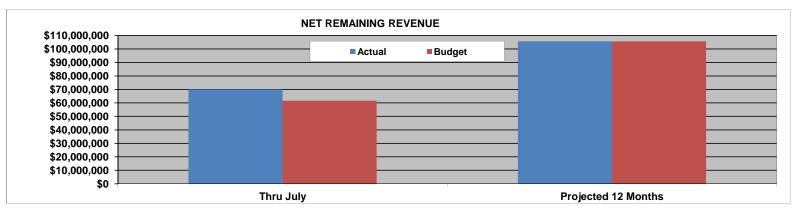

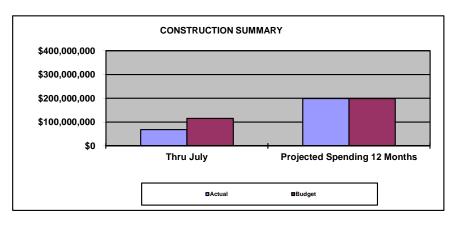

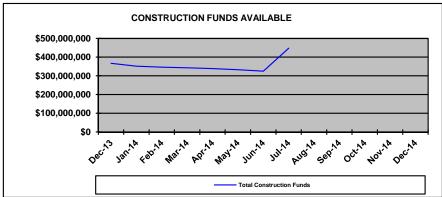

The year-to-date construction spending is at \$68.7 million. The 2014 budget for Capital Construction Program expenditures totals \$199.2 million.

Short-Term Liquidity Forecast: As of July 31, 2014 the Authority had \$447.7 million available in construction funds, which includes \$250.0 million on the shelf in Commercial Paper Series 1 fund. Of the funds on hand as of the end of July, \$29.8 million were PFC and Grant recycled funds. PFC and Grant recycled funds are available for the same purpose as AMT bond funds. Included in the funds on hand as of July 31 were \$2.1 million of non-AMT bond funds, the majority of which is from the 2010A debt issuance.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during July include the following:

- The largest decrease for Airline delinquencies is primarily due to payments from American Eagle Airlines in the amount of \$93,612, for several types of invoices.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during the month of July include the following:

- The increase in Airline delinquencies is primarily due to several landing fees that are open. The most significant amount is \$104,586 for Saudi Arabian Airlines. The second largest delinquency is JetBlue with an open amount of \$71,315.
- The small decrease of Non-Airline delinquencies is primarily due to a payment made from Cargo Airport Services in the amount of \$30,000.
- The Government had no significant changes.
- Telecommunications had a decrease of 9.3% which is a result of a payment from Air Wisconsin in the amount of \$3,127.

We have been unable to bill the following due to unsigned lease agreements:

- Sky Chefs currently has \$280,000 in delinquent balances due an unsigned amendment to their contract. Unpaid balances date back to November 2013.
- PMC agreement expired December 2013, amendment not signed, unable to bill since May 2014.
- PR Bistro amendment not signed resulting in \$5,400 in unbilled percentage concessions.

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Aviation Enterprise Fund – Highlights in Brief

- Total operating revenues for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for August 2014 were \$61.1 million. Operating revenues increased from July 2014 by \$0.1 million mostly due to increases in international arrival fees of \$0.6 million, other revenue of \$0.2, concessions of \$0.1 million, rents of \$0.1 million and security fees of \$0.1 million offset by decreases in landing fees of \$1.0 million.
- Year-to-date operating revenues through August 2014 were \$475.9 million, which is a decrease of \$7.4 million below 2013 totals. Landing fees decreased by \$8.5 million, rents decreased by \$7.6 million and international arrival fees decreased by \$0.8 million. The decreases are offset by increases in concessions of \$7.1 million, security fees of \$0.9 million, other revenue of \$0.6 million, passenger conveyance fees of \$0.6 million and utilities sales of \$0.3 million.
- Total operating expenses for the Aviation Enterprise Fund during the month of August 2014 were \$47.5 million, which is \$5.7 million lower than for July 2014 mostly due to decreases in services of \$4.3 million, salaries and related benefits of \$0.6 million, and materials and supplies of \$0.5 million, utilities of \$0.2 million and project expenses of \$0.2 million, offset by increases in depreciation and amortization of \$0.2 million.
- Year-to-date operating expenses through August 2014 were \$407.3 million, which is \$7.7 million higher than 2013 primarily due to increases in services of \$6.4 million, materials and supplies of \$1.6 million, project expenses of \$1.2 million, salaries and related benefits of \$1.2 million and telecommunications of \$0.2 million offset by decreases in depreciation and amortization of \$2.4 million, travel of \$0.1 million, utilities of \$0.1 million, lease from the U.S. government of \$0.1 million and insurance of \$0.1 million.
- Operating income for the Aviation Enterprise Fund in August 2014 was \$13.6 million compared to operating income of \$7.8 million in July 2014.
- Year-to-date through August 2014, operating income was \$68.6 million compared to operating income of \$83.7 million through August 2013.

- → In August 2014 there was a net non-operating loss of \$27.8 million compared to a net non-operating loss in July 2014 of \$15.2 million. The negative difference of \$12.6 million is primarily due to a \$14.0 million decrease in the swaps fair value offset by a decrease in interest expense of \$0.5 million and higher investment gains of \$0.9 million.
- Through August 2014, year-to-date net non-operating expenses were \$168.1 million compared to net non-operating expenses of \$65.8 million in 2013. The negative difference of \$102.3 million is mostly comprised of a \$110.0 million decrease in the swaps fair value offset by a decrease in interest expense of \$4.1 million and an increase in investment gains of \$3.6 million.
- The capital contributions for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of August 2014 were \$11.4 million compared to \$9.6 million in July 2014. The \$1.8 million increase is due to a \$0.9 million increase in grant revenue and a \$0.9 increase in passenger facility charges. Year-to-date capital contributions were \$97.9 million, a decrease of \$4.5 million from 2013, due to decreases of \$5.7 million in grant revenue offset by increases to passenger facilities charges of \$1.2 million in grant revenue.
- → There is a decrease in net position for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of August 2014 of \$2.8 million compared to an increase of \$2.2 million for the prior month.
- The year-to-date decrease in net position through August 2014 was \$1.6 million compared to a year-to-date increase of \$120.3 million through August 2013.
- Accounts receivables delinquent over 30 days, including amounts past due which are in bankruptcy proceedings, had a balance of \$1.6 million as of August 31, 2014, a decrease of 5.7% from July 31, 2014. Delinquent accounts receivables for customer accounts which have a net credit balance are excluded from reported delinquent receivables.
- → Debt service coverage increased from 1.39x in July 2014 to 1.42x in August 2014.

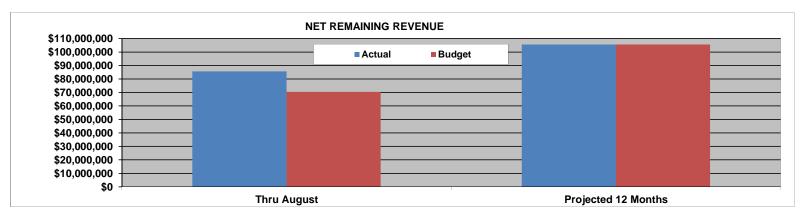

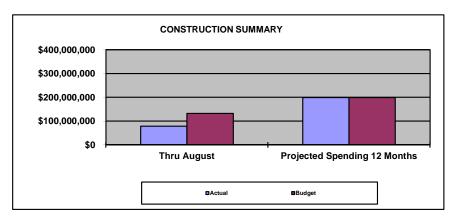

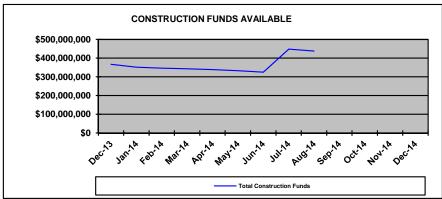

The year-to-date construction spending is at \$78.7 million. The 2014 budget for Capital Construction Program expenditures totals \$199.2 million.

Short-Term Liquidity Forecast: As of August 31, 2014 the Authority had \$437.9 million available in construction funds, which includes \$250.0 million on the shelf in Commercial Paper Series 1 fund. Of the funds on hand as of the end of August, \$29.8 million were PFC and Grant recycled funds. PFC and Grant recycled funds are available for the same purpose as AMT bond funds. Included in the funds on hand as of August 31 were \$2.1 million of non-AMT bond funds, the majority of which is from the 2010A debt issuance.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during the month of August include the following:

- The largest decrease in Airline delinquencies is primarily due to a payment of \$81,335 from JetBlue for Rent.
- The small decrease of Non-Airline delinquencies is primarily due to a payment made from Cargo Airport Services in the amount of \$30,000.
- The Government had a small increase of \$727.00 due to outstanding balance for Federal Aviation Agency.
- Telecommunications had an increase of 7.2% which is attributed to a Host International Inc balance of \$2,306.

We have been unable to bill the following due to unsigned lease agreements:

- Sky Chefs currently has \$349,000 in delinquent balances due an unsigned amendment to their contract. Unpaid balances date back to November 2013.
- PMC agreement expired December 2013, amendment not signed, unable to bill since May 2014 @ \$37,100 a month.
- PR Bistro amendment not signed resulting in \$6,800 of unbilled rent and \$3,251 of unbilled percentage concessions.
