

# Report to the Business Administration Committee Pre-Solicitation Terms For Aircraft Deicing Fluid Recovery, Disposal and Recycling Services Contract at Washington Dulles International and Ronald Reagan Washington National Airports

March 2014



### **PURPOSE**

Staff requests that the Business Administration Committee concur with the issuance of a Request For Proposals (RFP) to select a firm to provide Aircraft Deicing Fluid (ADF – propylene glycol) recovery, disposal, and recycling services at Washington Dulles International and Ronald Reagan National Airports.



# **Background**

This service contract requirement is to capture spent aircraft deicing fluids before they can enter the storm drainage systems at each Airport.

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (Airports Authority) is regulated by existing storm water discharge and sanitary waste water permits. The Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (VPDES) permit requires a storm water pollution prevention plan that includes measures to minimize the discharge of spent aircraft deicing fluid from aircraft deicing activities into the storm sewer system.



The incumbent contractor is Inland Technologies International, Ltd, of Fairfax, VA.

The current contract expires on May 1, 2015.

The proposed solicitation will be for a five-year base period with five one-year option periods.

The Business Office has determined that there will not be any LDBE participation in this contract offering.

The annual value for both airports combined is projected to be \$4.2 million.



Full and open competition will be achieved through a best value competitive negotiated procurement. Under the "best value" procurement process, award is made to the responsible Offeror whose proposal provides the best overall value to the Airports Authority.
