WHEREAS, The proposals which were submitted in response to the RFP have been reviewed and evaluated by an evaluation committee, and the results of the committee's review and evaluation have been reported to the Audit - Legal Committee; and

WHEREAS, After reviewing these results, the Audit - Legal Committee has recommended to the Board the selection of the law firm of and has further recommend that the Board authorize
contract negotiations to begin with that firm; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED, That, conditioned upon the successful negotiation of a contract, the law firm of is selected to become bond and disclosure counsel for the Airports Authority's Aviation Enterprise;
