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- ✤ Total operating revenues for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for August 2013 were \$63.2 million. Operating revenues increased from July 2013 by \$0.9 million mostly due to increases in landing fees of \$0.6 million, international arrival fees of \$0.4 million, utility sales of \$0.4 million, security fees of \$0.3 million and other revenues of \$0.1 million offset by decreases in rents of \$0.4 million and concessions of \$0.4 million.
- Year-to-date operating revenues through August 2013 were \$483.3 million, which is an increase of \$29.7 million over 2012 totals. Rent revenue increases of \$15.1 million, landing fees of \$7.4 million, passenger conveyance fees of \$0.6 million and international arrival fees of \$0.7 million were higher primarily due to higher rates. In addition to the rate increases, concessions were higher by \$6.0 million, utility sales were higher by \$0.3 million and security fees were lower by\$0.5 million.
- ★ Total operating expenses for the Aviation Enterprise Fund during the month of August 2013 were \$50.1 million, which is \$1.1 million lower than for July 2013 mostly due to decreases in salaries and related benefits of \$0.4 million, project expenses of \$0.3 million, depreciation and amortization of \$0.2 million, services of \$0.2 million and insurance of \$0.1 million offset by increases in materials and supplies of \$0.1 million and utilities of \$0.1 million.
- Year-to-date operating expenses through August 2013 were \$400.0 million, which is higher than 2012 by \$1.9 million primarily due to increases in salaries and related benefits of \$3.2 million, depreciation and amortization of \$1.8 million, services of \$1.3 million offset by decreases in project expenses of \$3.6 million, utilities of \$0.5 million, insurance of \$0.2 million, telecommunications of \$0.1 million and travel of \$0.1 million.
- → Operating income for the Aviation Enterprise Fund in August 2013 was \$13.2 million compared to operating income of \$11.2 million in July 2013.
- ✤ Year-to-date through August 2013, operating income was \$83.7 million compared to operating income of \$55.9 million through August 2012.

- ➤ In August 2013 there was a net non-operating loss of \$10.5 million compared to a net non-operating loss in July 2013 of \$7.7 million. This is an increase in net non-operating loss of about \$2.8 million. The increase is primarily due to a decrease in investment gains of \$1.2 million, an increase in interest expense of \$1.1 million and \$0.7 million decrease in the change in the swaps fair value offset by \$0.1 million increase in federal, state and local grants.
- → Through August 2013, year-to-date net non-operating expenses were \$65.8 million compared to net non-operating expenses of \$149.1 million in 2012. The positive difference of \$83.2 million is mostly comprised of an \$85.3 million positive difference in the change in the swaps fair value and a reduction in interest expense of \$1.2 million offset by a decrease in investment gains of \$3.3 million.
- → The capital contributions for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of August 2013 were \$17.8 million compared to \$9.0 million in July 2013. The \$8.8 million increase is mostly due to an increase of \$9.0 million in grants revenue offset by a decrease of \$0.1 million in passenger facility charges. Year-to-date capital contributions were \$102.4 million, an increase of \$14.3 million from 2012, due to an increase of \$15.1 million in grant revenue offset by a decrease of \$0.8 million in passenger facility charges.
- → There is an increase in net position for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of August 2013 of \$20.5 million compared to \$12.5 million for the prior month.
- → The year-to-date increase in net position through August 2013 was \$120.3 million, compared to a year-to-date decrease of \$5.1 million through August 2012.
- Accounts receivables delinquent over 30 days, including amounts past due which are in bankruptcy proceedings, had a balance of \$2.0 million as of August 31, 2013, an increase of 55.7% from July 31, 2013. Delinquent accounts receivables for customer accounts which have a net credit balance are excluded from reported delinquent receivables.
- \rightarrow Debt service coverage increased from 1.42x in July 2013 to 1.44x in August 2013.

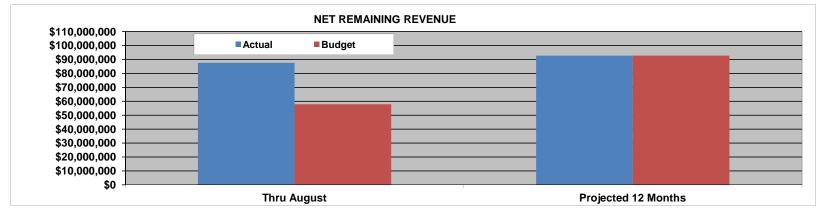

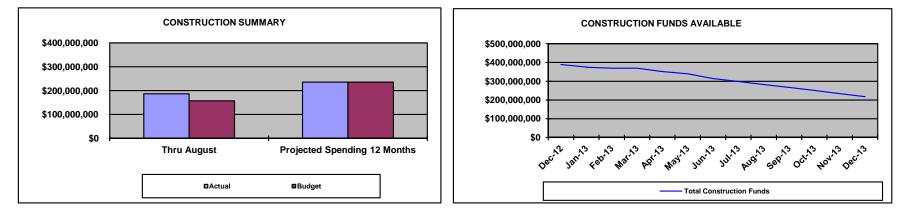

The year-to-date construction spending is at \$187.1 million. The 2013 budget for Capital Construction Program expenditures totals \$235.9 million.

Short-Term Liquidity Forecast: As of August 31, 2013 the Authority had \$282.9 million available in construction funds, which includes \$250.0 million on the shelf in Commercial Paper Series 1 fund. Of the funds on hand as of the end of August, \$18.3 million were PFC and Grant recycled funds. PFC and Grant recycled funds are available for the same purpose as AMT bond funds. Included in the funds on hand as of August 31 were \$2.4 million of non-AMT bond funds, the majority of which is from the 2010A debt issuance.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during August include the following:

- The increase in Airline delinquencies is primarily due to Frontier Airlines landing fee invoices in the amount of \$133,155, minus a credit in the amount of \$52,522 for a net amount of \$80,633.
- The Non-Airlines increase in delinquencies is attributed to LSG Sky Chef in the amount of \$161,242. These invoices consist of July and August rents. The delinquency is due to a contractual dispute with MWAA.
- The Government delinquencies decreased by \$79,964. The largest decrease is attributed to a payment in the amount of 79,964.00 from TSA.
- The increase in Telecommunication's delinquencies is primarily the result of an increase of \$10,962.00 for TSA Telecommunication invoices. TSA represents the largest amount of the delinquency in the amount of \$22,690.00.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during the month of August include the following:

- The increase in Airline delinquencies is primarily due to a landing fee in the amount of \$162,683 for Mesa Airlines. The second most significant increase in delinquency is Republic Airlines in the amount of \$79,356 for landing fees.
- The increase in Non-Airline delinquencies is primarily due to a delinquent Swissport rent and landing fee in the amount of \$45,313 minus a credit in the amount of \$23,800 for a net amount of \$21,513.00.
- The Government delinquency decrease is attributed to a \$73,000 payment for TSA invoices.
- The Telecommunications increase is primarily due a delinquency of \$17,548.00 for AECOMM Technology.
