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Aviation Enterprise Fund – Highlights in Brief

- Total operating revenues for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for November 2014 were \$61.1 million. Operating revenues decreased from October 2014 by \$0.4 million mostly due to decreases in concessions of \$0.3 million, rents of \$0.2 million and landing fees of \$0.2 million offset by increases in utility sales of \$0.2 million.
- Year-to-date operating revenues through November 2014 were \$659.8 million, which is a decrease of \$6.6 million from 2013 totals. Landing fees decreased by \$12.3 million, rents decreased by \$11.7 million and international arrival fees decreased by \$0.5 million. The decreases are offset by increases in concessions of \$14.9 million, security fees of \$0.9 million, other revenue of \$0.9 million, passenger conveyance fees of \$0.8 million and utility sales of \$0.3 million.
- Total operating expenses for the Aviation Enterprise Fund during the month of November 2014 were \$49.9 million, which is \$4.5 million lower than for October 2014 mostly due to decreases in services of \$2.8 million, salaries and related benefits of \$2.0 million and materials and supplies of \$0.2 million offset by project expenses of \$0.4 million and utilities of \$0.2 million.
- Year-to-date operating expenses through November 2014 were \$562.5 million, which is \$8.9 million higher than 2013 primarily due to increases in services of \$8.2 million, salaries and related benefits of \$2.1 million, materials and supplies of \$1.3 million, project expenses of \$1.2 million, telecommunications of \$0.2 million and utilities of \$0.1 million offset by decreases in depreciation and amortization of \$3.2 million, insurance of \$0.7 million, travel of \$0.1 million and non-cash expenses of \$0.1 million.
- Operating income for the Aviation Enterprise Fund in November 2014 was \$11.1 million compared to operating income of \$7.1 million in October 2014.
- Year-to-date through November 2014, operating income was \$97.3 million compared to operating income of \$112.7 million through November 2013.

- → In November 2014 there was a net non-operating loss of \$22.2 million compared to a net non-operating loss in October 2014 of \$20.4 million. The negative difference of \$1.8 million is primarily due to a \$2.7 million increase in interest expense and a decrease in investment gains of \$0.6 million offset by an increase in the swaps fair value of \$1.5 million.
- Through November 2014, year-to-date net non-operating expenses were \$219.2 million compared to net non-operating expenses of \$118.7 million in 2013. The negative difference of \$100.5 million is mostly comprised of a \$115.6 million decrease in the swaps fair value offset by a decrease in interest expense of \$11.9 million and an increase in investment gains of \$3.2 million.
- The capital contributions for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of November 2014 were \$9.2 million compared to \$8.6 million in October 2014. The \$0.5 million increase is due to a \$2.3 million increase in grant revenue and a \$1.7 million decrease in passenger facility charges. Year-to-date capital contributions were \$128.1 million, a decrease of \$15.4 million from 2013 due to decreases of \$8.5 million in other capital property contributed and grant revenue of \$9.7 million offset by increases to passenger facilities charges of \$2.8 million.
- There is a decrease in net position for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of November 2014 of \$1.9 million compared to a decrease of \$4.7 million for the prior month.
- The year-to-date increase in net position through November 2014 was \$6.1 million compared to a year-to-date increase of 137.5 million through November 2013.
- Accounts receivables delinquent over 30 days, including amounts past due which are in bankruptcy proceedings, had a balance of \$2.2 million as of November 30, 2014, an increase of 1.6% from October 31, 2014. Delinquent accounts receivables for customer accounts which have a net credit balance are excluded from reported delinquent receivables.
- → Debt service coverage increased from 1.43x in October 2014 to 1.44 in November 2014.

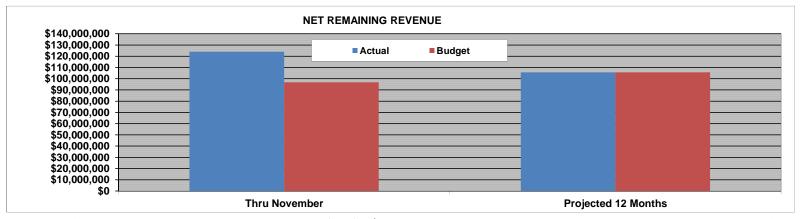

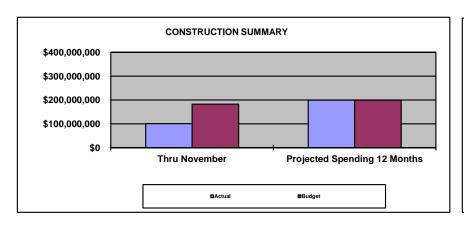

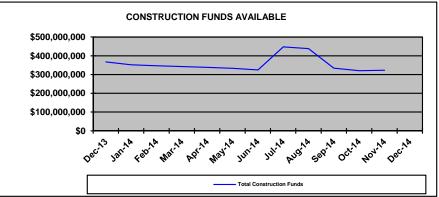

The year-to-date construction spending is at \$101.1 million. The 2014 budget for Capital Construction Program expenditures totals \$199.2 million.

Short-Term Liquidity Forecast: As of November 30, 2014 the Authority had \$322.6 million available in construction funds, which includes \$179.0 million on the shelf in Commercial Paper Series 2 fund. Of the funds on hand as of the end of Novemver, \$43.85 million were PFC and Grant recycled funds. PFC and Grant recycled funds are available for the same purpose as AMT bond funds.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during November include the following:

- The largest decrease for Airline delinquencies is primarily due to several payments from American Airlines for \$126,329.
- The largest increase for Non-Airlines delinquencies is attributed to a concession balance of \$34,288 and some other small utility invoices. Customer also has several credits which total \$11,566 leaving a balance of \$25,909.
- The largest increase for Government Delinquencies is primarily due to rent and utility invoices of \$42,054 for Transportation Security Administration.
- Telecommunications delinquency had a small increase of .2% which is attributed to Transportation Security Administration balance of \$81.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during the month of November include the following:

- The largest decrease in Airline delinquencies is primarily due to payments of \$190,009 from Air China for outstanding rent, passenger fees, and gate charges. The second largest decrease is from Silver Airways which paid their landing fees of \$112,567.
- The largest increase of Non-Airline delinquencies is attributed to Air Serv Corp which has an open invoice for parking permits of \$137,545.
- The Government had a decrease of -39.7% which was due to a payment from General Services Agency (TSA) of \$64,693.
- Telecommunications had an increase of 10.4% which is attributed to Etihad Airways for \$3,735.
