

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February 2013 Air Traffic Summary

Below is a summary of the February 2013 Air Traffic Statistics Report, which contains passenger data for National and Dulles as well as cargo data for Dulles. This report also contains comparative BWI Airport statistics and Airlines for America (A4A) U.S. Industry passenger and cargo statistics.

National

- Current Month Activity vs. February 2012
 - The overall growth in February 2013 passenger traffic was primarily driven by 8.9% growth in domestic traffic:
 - JetBlue's new service to San Juan and Tampa and increased service to Boston, Ft. Lauderdale, and Orlando
 - Activity growth for US Airways mainline and regional, Southwest (new service to Austin and St. Louis), and Delta (increased service to Memphis and Salt Lake City), was offset by declines in Delta Connection, Frontier, and Spirit (Spirit ceased service, effective October 2012)
 - Transborder passenger traffic growth of 56.7% was primarily driven by US Airways Express service to Montreal Dorval and Toronto
- US Airways mainline had the largest passenger market share with 21.8% in February 2013
 - US Airways mainline activity increased 10.5% compared to February 2012
- DCA surpassed IAD by 20.3 K passengers
- February 2013 total passengers growth of 9.5% was ahead of A4A U. S. Industry average enplanement rate of -0.9%
- 2013 YTD passenger traffic growth of 12.3% was ahead of A4A U.S. Industry average enplanement growth rate of 0.6%

Dulles

- Current Month Activity vs. February 2012
 - The overall decline in February 2013 passenger traffic was primarily driven by the extra leap-year day in February 2012 and an 11.7% decline in domestic traffic:
 - Overall domestic activity declines for United mainline and regional
 - JetBlue service to Ft. Lauderdale and Orlando was repositioned to DCA
 - Reduced JetBlue capacity to Boston and JFK

Dulles (continued)

- Reduced Virgin America capacity to Los Angeles and San Francisco
- Reduced American capacity to Dallas/Fort Worth and Los Angeles
- Reduced Southwest capacity to Chicago Midway
- Reduced Delta capacity to Atlanta and ceased service to Minneapolis and Salt Lake City
- Net decrease of 4,789 daily seats or -16.8%
- International traffic growth of 5.0% was primarily driven by growth by Copa, Saudi Arabia, Turkish, and Ethiopian as well as new service:
 - Emirates to Dubai
 - Aeromexico to Mexico City
 - Porter Airlines to Toronto City Centre
- United mainline had the largest passenger market share with 42.8% in February 2013
 - United mainline activity decreased 2.8% compared to February 2012
- Total cargo (mail and freight)
 - Decreased 8.0% compared to February 2012 and lagged A4A U.S. Industry average rate of -7.5%
 - Domestic: decrease of 16.5% was primarily driven by United downsizing from wide-body to narrow-body to and from the West Coast
 - International: decrease of 1.8% was primarily due to United's decrease in Government/Military air exports and downsizing of wide-body flights as well as declines for Air France, and British Airways, which were offset by growth in Emirates and Federal Express
- February 2013 total passenger decline of 7.5% lagged A4A U. S. Industry average enplanement rate of -0.9%
- 2013 YTD passenger traffic decline of 5.3% lagged A4A U.S. Industry average enplanement growth rate of 0.6%

BWI

- Current Month Activity vs. February 2012
 - February 2013 total passengers of 1.5 M decreased 3.3% compared to February 2012, and lagged the A4A U. S. Industry average enplanement rate of -0.9%
 - BWI surpassed IAD by 46.8 K passengers
 - BWI surpassed National by 26.5 K passengers
 - Southwest+AirTran had the largest passenger market share with 70.7%
 - Southwest+AirTran activity decreased 3.7% compared to February 2012








Four Year Comparison of the Month of February
