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Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority Financial Statements March 2013 Aviation Enterprise Fund – Highlights in Brief

- ✤ Total operating revenues for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for March 2013 were \$59.8 million. Operating revenues increased from February 2013 by \$3.3 million mostly due to increases in concessions of \$2.1 million, landing fees of \$1.8 million offset by decreases in rents of \$0.2 million, and international arrival fees of \$0.2 million.
- Year-to-date operating revenues through March 2013 were \$176.1 million, which is an increase of \$9.9 million over 2012 totals. Increases in revenues are due primarily to higher rates, represented by increases in rent revenues of \$4.9 million, landing fees of \$2.6 million, concessions of \$1.5 million, passenger conveyance fees of \$0.3 million, utility sales of \$0.3 million, and international arrival fees of \$0.2 million.
- ★ Total operating expenses for the Aviation Enterprise Fund during the month of March 2013 were \$47.1 million, which is \$2.1 million lower than for February 2013 mostly due to decreases in salaries and related benefits of \$1.3 million, services of \$0.9 million, depreciation and amortization of \$0.7 million, and materials and supplies of \$0.3 million, offset by increases in utilities of \$0.9 million, insurance of \$0.2 million, and telecommunications of \$0.1 million.
- Year-to-date operating expenses through March 2013 were \$147.8 million, which is higher than 2012 by \$1.5 million primarily due to increases in services of \$2.8 million, depreciation and amortization of \$1.4 million, and project expenses of \$0.3, offset by decreases in materials and supplies of \$1.9 million, insurance of \$0.6 million, salaries and related benefits of \$0.5 million, and travel of \$0.1 million.
- ✤ Operating income for the Aviation Enterprise Fund in March 2013 was \$12.7 million compared to operating income of \$7.2 million in February 2013.
- → Year-to-date through March 2013, operating income was \$28.3 million compared to the operating income of \$20.0 million through March 2012.
- → Net non-operating expenses in March 2013 were \$12.8 million compared to net non-operating expenses in February 2013 of \$19.9 million. This is a decrease in net non-operating expenses of about \$7.1 million primarily due to a \$7.6 million increase in the change in the swaps fair value and an increase in federal, state and local grants of \$0.4 million, offset by increases in interest expense of \$0.7 million and investment losses of \$0.2 million.

- → Through March 2013, year-to-date net non-operating expenses were \$32.6 million compared to net non-operating expenses of \$24.7 million in 2012. The negative difference of \$7.9 million is mostly comprised of a \$9.7 million negative difference in the change in the swaps fair value, offset by a reduction in interest expense of \$1.2 million, an increase in grants of \$0.5 million and an unrealized investment gain of \$0.1 million.
- → The capital contributions for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of March 2013 were \$12.7 million compared to \$11.0 million in February 2013. The \$1.7 million increase is mostly due to increases of \$1.5 million in passenger facility charges and \$0.2 million in federal, state and local grants. Year-to-date capital contributions were almost \$29.1 million, up by \$1.7 million from 2012, due to an increase of \$ 2.7 million in grants offset by a decrease of \$1.0 million in passenger facility charges.
- ✤ There is an increase in net position for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of March 2013 of \$12.6 million as compared to a decrease in net position for the prior month of \$1.6 million.
- → The year-to-date increase in net position through March 2013 was \$24.9 million, compared to a year-to-date increase in net position of \$22.7 million through March 2012.
- Accounts receivables delinquent over 30 days, including amounts past due which are in bankruptcy proceedings, had a balance of \$2.7 million as of March 31, 2013, a decrease of 36.3% from February 28, 2013. Delinquent accounts receivables for customer accounts which have a net credit balance are excluded from reported delinquent receivables.
- → Debt service coverage increased from 1.33x in February 2013 to 1.35x in March 2013.

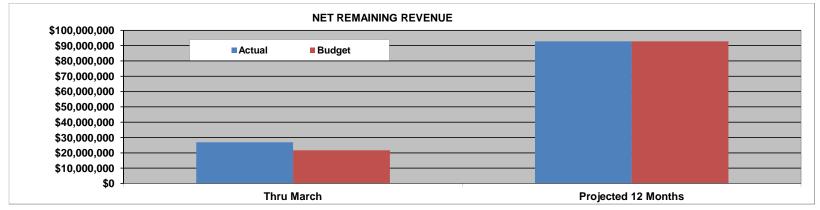

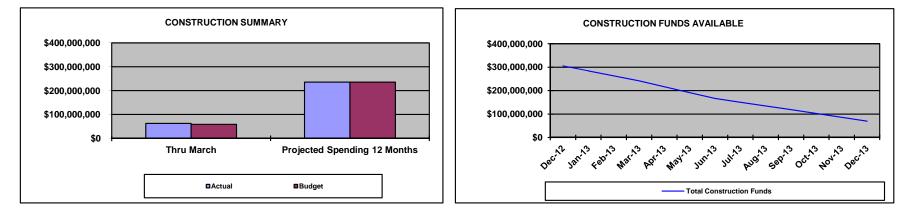

The year-to-date construction spending is at \$62.6 million. The 2013 budget for Capital Construction Program expenditures totals \$235.9 million.

Short-Term Liquidity Forecast: As of March 31, 2013 the Authority had \$241.9 million available in construction funds, which includes \$232.5 million on the shelf in Commercial Paper Series 1 fund. Of the funds on hand as of the end of March, \$74.9 million were PFC and Grant recycled funds. PFC and Grant recycled funds are available for the same purpose as AMT bond funds. Included in the funds on hand as of March 31 were \$800 thousand of non-AMT bond funds, the majority of which is from the 2010A debt issuance.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during March include the following:

- The decrease in the Airlines delinquencies is primarily the result of a payment in the amount of \$104,312 from American Eagle Airlines offset by the US Airways delinquency in the amount of \$57,826 for signatory passenger fees and \$1,316 in landing fees. Currently, US Airways represents the largest amount of the delinquency totaling \$188,085 which primarily consists of rent, parking permits and utility invoices.
- The Non- Airlines decrease in delinquencies is attributed to receipt of \$48,297 from The Boeing Company. Aircraft Service International has the largest nonairline delinquency balance in the amount of \$9,715, of which \$8,120 is for bulk parking.
- Government agencies delinquencies include \$103,885 for FAA and \$98,937 for TSA.
- TSA represents the largest amount of the delinquency in the amount of \$11,315.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during the month of March include the following:

- The decrease in Airline delinquencies is primarily due to receipt of \$510,315 from United Airlines and its affiliates for rent and landing fees. Currently, the top three increases in delinquencies are attributed to \$290,602 from Delta Airlines, \$288,923 from Turkish Airlines and \$195,569 from Virgin America, which primarily consist of rent and gate charge invoices.
- The increase in Non-Airline delinquencies is attributed to payment of \$60,364 from the Marriott Hotel at Dulles for rent invoices.
- The Government delinquencies decrease of 56.7% is attributed to receipts of \$69,326 from General Services Administration (TSA) and \$32,910 from The Smithsonian Institution. Currently, \$50,568 from FAA and \$29,028 from TSA make up the overall delinquent balance.
- The Telecommunications balance decrease is attributed to receipt of \$17,147 from Delta Airlines. Currently, JetBlue has the largest delinquent balance of \$6,696.
