

REPORT TO THE DULLES CORRIDOR COMMITTEE

PRE-SOLICITATION TERMS FOR WETLAND AND STREAM MITIGATION CREDIT PURCHASES FOR THE DULLES CORRIDOR METRORAIL PROJECT - PHASE 2

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PURPOSE

Request Dulles Corridor Committee concurrence of two separate solicitations. The first solicitation is for wetland mitigation and the second is for stream mitigation. Both are required for Phase 2 of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.



BACKGROUND

Airports Authority is responsible for mitigating the unavoidable impacts Phase 2 Rail construction will have on wetlands and streams.

Purchase of credits from established and approved Virginia Department of Environmental Quality mitigation bank is the cost-effective and ecologically preferable solution. The Airports Authority has successfully used a similar approach for aviation projects' impacts.

Environmental permits require that mitigation occurs within same watershed.



MITIGATION SCOPE

Wetlands: 9.37 acres of credit

Stream: 1,111 linear feet of credit

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Dulles Corridor Committee concur with the issuance of solicitations for the purchase of wetland mitigation credits and stream mitigation credits for Phase 2 of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project.
