

Airport Location:

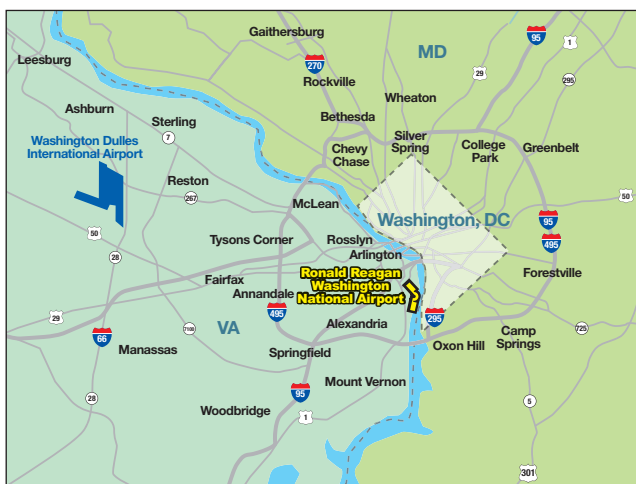
Across the Potomac River, about 4 miles from Downtown Washington, DC.

✈ **By car or taxi:** Just off the George Washington Memorial Parkway, about one mile south of I-395. Also accessible from U.S. Route 1 in Crystal City (Arlington, VA), via the ramps to Virginia Route 233.

✈ **Metrorail:** Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport Metro station on the Blue and Yellow lines.

- ✈ Some Airport shops are open 24 hours, including Faber News and Dunkin Donuts, located in National Hall outside security.
- ✈ Traveler currency exchange service is located near the north end of National Hall on the Concourse level. ATM machines are throughout the airport.

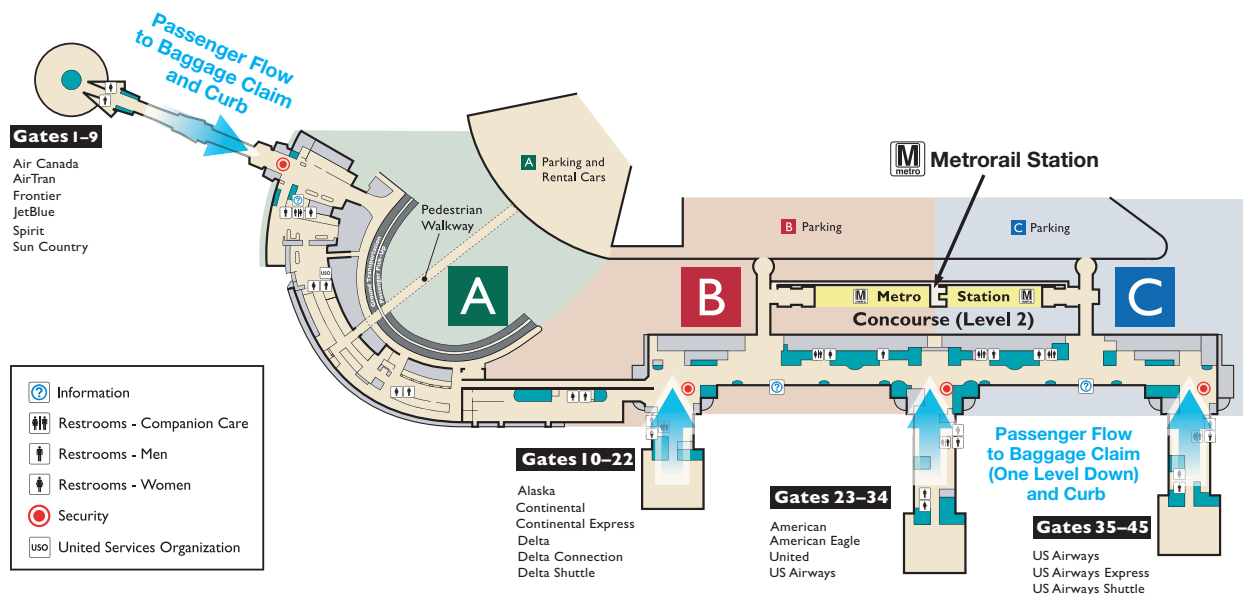
After you exit the plane – which way to go:

If you arrive at gates 1-9 you are in Terminal A.

Follow the signs to baggage claim – all services are on the same level as the gates. As you exit the building, taxis are at the first curb, shuttles are at the second curb and passenger pickup in private vehicles is at the third curb.

If you arrive at gates 10-35 you are in Terminal B/C.

Follow the signs to baggage claim. As you leave the gate area through the exit lanes, you will enter the Concourse level of National Hall. Go down one level to baggage claim, then streetside for ground transportation (first curb) and passenger pickup in private vehicles (second curb).



Ground Transportation - Getting to Downtown DC:

- **Taxi:** No reservations needed; board outside baggage claim area.
- **Rental Cars:** Most agencies located on-airport. Ride free "Parking/Rental Car" airport shuttle to reach on-airport rental locations.
- **Super Shuttle:** 1-800-BLUEVAN for information. Super Shuttle representatives are adjacent to bag claim #7 in Terminal B/C and curbside at Terminal A.
- **Metrorail:** 202-637-7000 or www.wmata.com. Both ends of the station are connected to the Concourse level of Terminal B/C. If coming from Terminal A you can walk indoors or ride the free "Parking/Rental Car" shuttle to the Garage B or C Metro stop. The Airport station is on the Blue and Yellow lines (see local map below).



Getting a Ride from Someone? Places to Meet Arriving Passengers Inside the Airport:

Greeting area locations are located outside the security screening checkpoints on the Concourse level:

- Gates 1-9: Terminal A. Nearest concession is Einstein Bros. Bagels.
- Gates 10-22: South end of Terminal B, Nearest concession is Dunkin Donuts.
- Gates 23-34: Center of Terminal B/C. Nearest concession is TGI Friday's.
- Gates 35-45: North end of Terminal C. Nearest concession is Mayorga Coffee.

Free Cell Phone Waiting Area: The person picking you up can wait in their vehicle for free up to one hour. Call them when you claim your bag and meet them on the curb outside for pickup. Be sure to tell them the letter of the terminal (A, B or C) you arrived at.

Getting Help at the Airport

Travelers Aid Information Desks--All are located outside security:

- Gates 1-9: Terminal A, just outside security checkpoint, phone 703-417-3972.
- Gates 10-45: Terminal B/C Concourse Level-two locations. Each is located where the walkways from Metro and Parking join the Concourse, phone 703-417-1806
- Terminal B/C baggage claim (lower) level: Across from baggage claim #6, phone 703-417-3974.

Lost and Found:

- Items left at security checkpoint: TSA: 703-417-0673
- Items left on the aircraft or jet way: Contact your airline
- Items left elsewhere: Airport Lost and Found Office 703-417-0673; office on the 1st floor of Terminal A, Room M-16 (Across from the USO)
