- International cargo increased 18.8% or 3,075 primarily due to increases by United (13.3%, or 739), Qatar(58.0%, or 432), Air China (89.7% or 399), and British (40.5%, or 319)

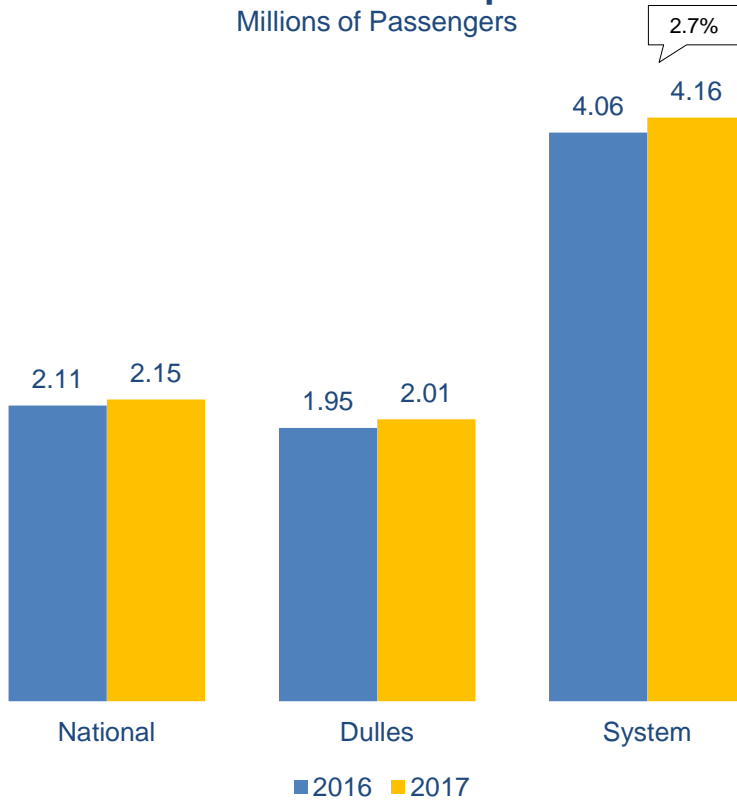

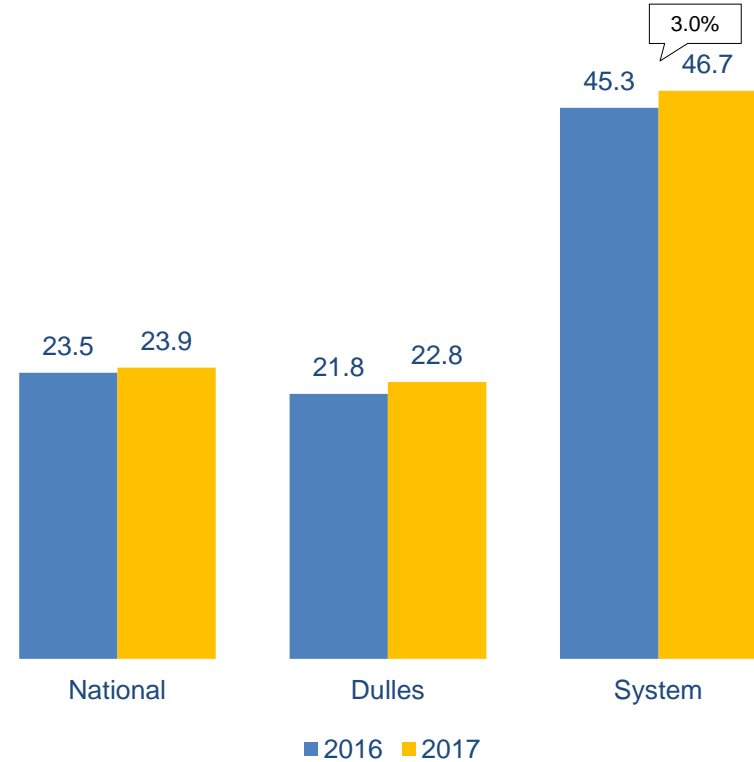
Current Month Comparison

Last 12-Months Comparison

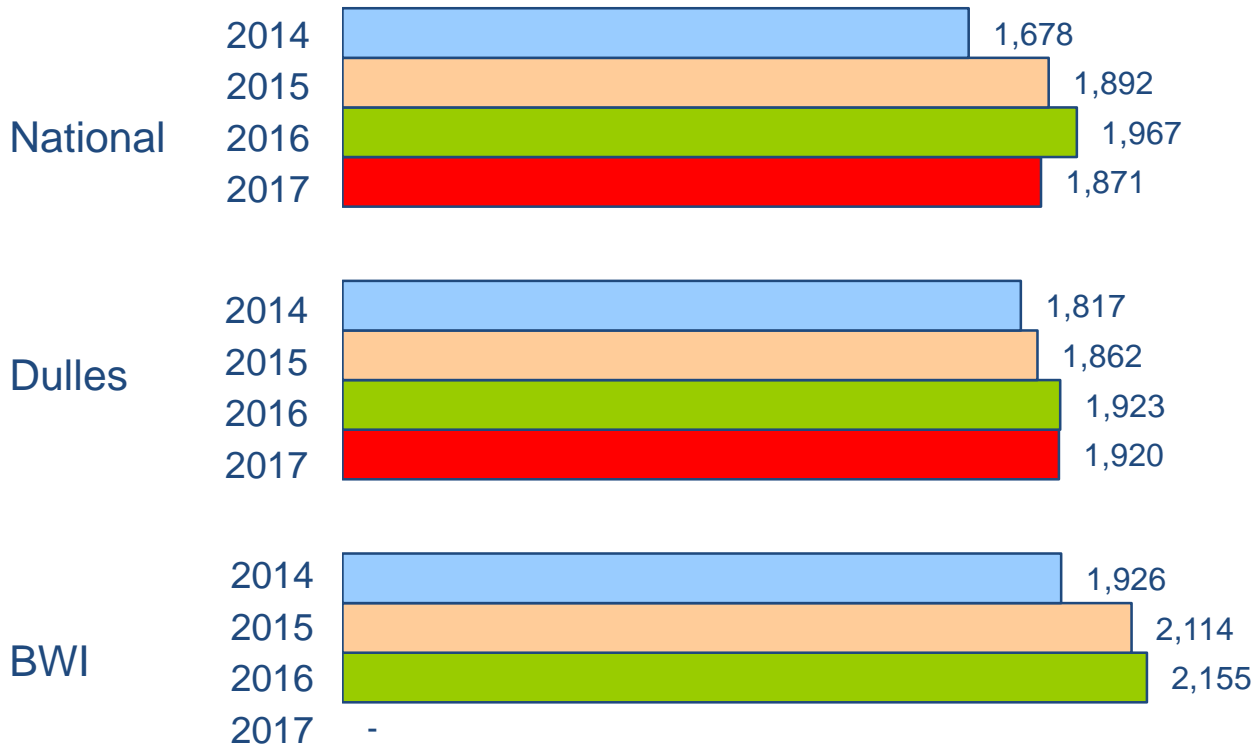

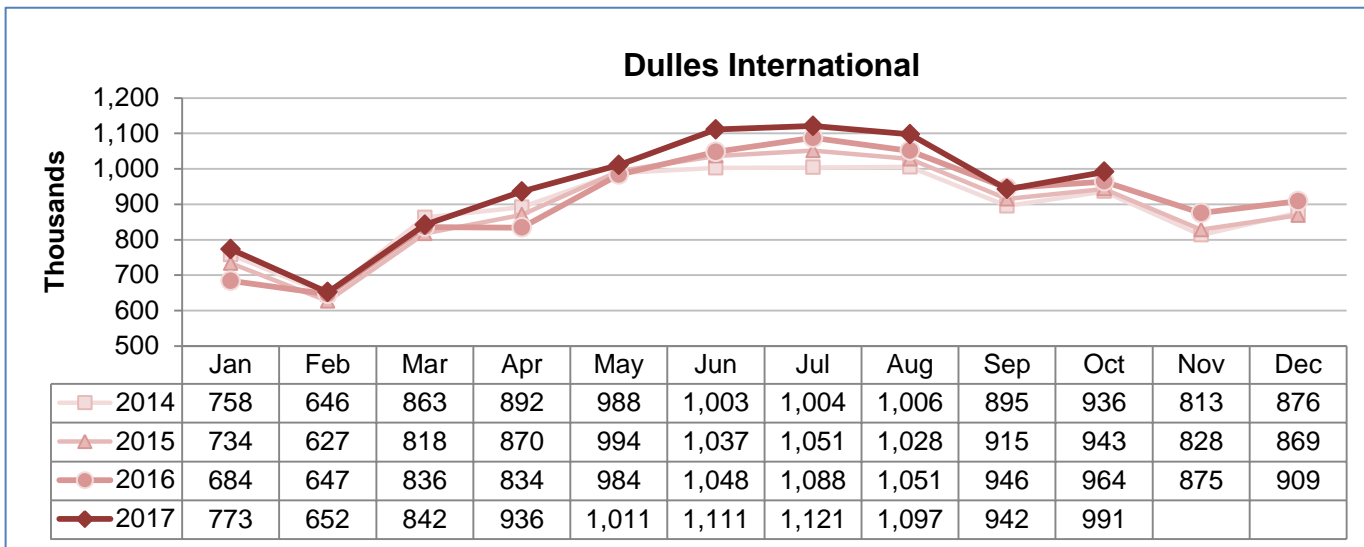
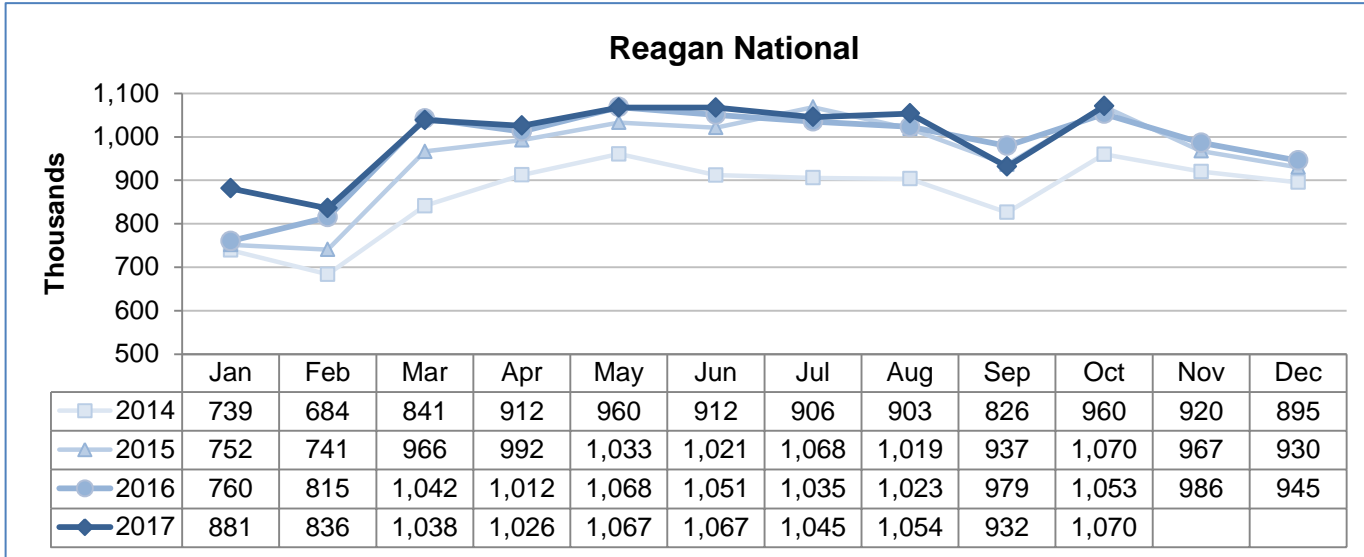


Regional Total Air Traffic Passengers 4Yr Comparison of the Current Month (‘000s)
