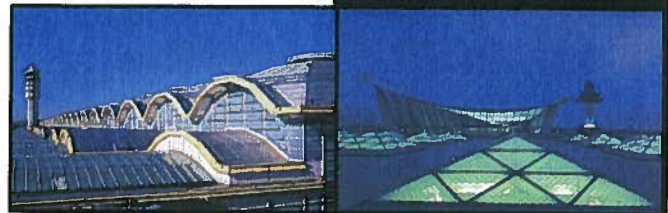

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Air Traffic Summary

Below is a summary of the March 2013 Air Traffic Statistics Report, which contains passenger data for National and Dulles as well as cargo data for Dulles. This report also contains comparative BWI Airport and Airlines for America (A4A) U.S. Industry passenger statistics. The A4A cargo statistics are not yet available.

National

- Current Month Activity vs. March 2012 increased 8.3% and was primarily driven by 7.8% growth in *domestic* traffic:
 - **US Airways (mainline and regional)**
 - New service to Augusta, Cincinnati, Key West, Minneapolis/St. Paul, Omaha, and San Diego
 - Increased service to Buffalo, Islip, Myrtle Beach, Savannah, Tallahassee, and Wilmington
 - **JetBlue**
 - New service to San Juan and Tampa
 - Increased service to Boston, Ft. Lauderdale, and Orlando
 - **Southwest**
 - New service to Austin and St. Louis
 - **American**
 - New service to Los Angeles and St. Louis
 - **Delta Connection**
 - Increased service to Salt Lake City
 - **Frontier**
 - Increased service to Madison
- Offsetting the increases were the following reductions in domestic service:
 - **US Airways (mainline and regional)**
 - Reduced service to Little Rock
 - Discontinued service to Dallas/Ft. Worth
 - **American**
 - Reduced service to Dallas/Ft. Worth and Miami
 - **Delta Connection**
 - Discontinued service to Boston, Charleston, Des Moines, Grand Rapids, Harford, and Indianapolis

- **Frontier**
 - Reduced service to Kansas City
 - Discontinued service to Grand Rapids and Milwaukee
 - **Spirit**
 - Discontinued operations, effective October 2012
- *Transborder* passenger traffic growth of 44.0% was primarily driven by US Airways Express's new service to Halifax, Montreal Dorval, and Toronto
- US Airways mainline had the largest passenger market share with 21.0%; activity increased 4.2% compared to March 2012
- March 2013 total passenger growth of 8.3% was ahead of A4A U.S. Industry average enplanement growth rate of 2.4%
- 2013 YTD total passenger growth of 10.7% was ahead of A4A U.S. Industry average enplanement growth rate of 1.3%

Dulles

- Current Month Activity vs. March 2012 decreased 5.3% and was primarily driven by a 9.7% decline in *domestic* traffic:
 - **United (mainline and regional)**
 - Reduced service to Hartford and Miami
 - Discontinued service to Westchester County
 - **JetBlue**
 - Discontinued service to Ft. Lauderdale
 - Repositioned service to Orlando from Dulles to National
 - **Delta**
 - Discontinued service to Cincinnati and Salt Lake City
 - **Southwest**
 - Discontinued service to Atlanta
 - **American**
 - Reduced service to Dallas/Ft. Worth
 - **Virgin America**
 - Reduced service to San Francisco
- Offsetting the declines were the following increases in domestic service:
 - **United (mainline and regional)**
 - New service to Fayetteville, Ft. Lauderdale, Greenbrier, Honolulu, and Johnstown
 - **Delta**
 - New service to New York LaGuardia

- *International/Transborder* passenger traffic growth of 6.5% was primarily driven by:
 - **COPA**
 - Increased service to Panama City
 - **Lufthansa**
 - Increased service to Frankfurt
 - **Emirates**
 - New service to Dubai
 - **Aeromexico**
 - New service to Mexico City
 - **Porter**
 - New service to Toronto City Centre
- United mainline had the largest passenger market share with 42.5%; activity decreased 1.5% compared to March 2012
- Total cargo (mail and freight) activity decreased 9.8% compared to March 2012 and was primarily driven by:
 - Domestic decrease of 15.8% as a result of United downsizing from wide-body to narrow-body flights to and from the West Coast
 - International decrease of 5.5% as a result of continued European economic uncertainty and the drawdown of government/military activity in Afghanistan
- United, British Airways, and Air France all experienced declines in cargo activity, which were moderately offset by new operations for Emirates
- March 2013 total passenger decline of 5.3% lagged A4A U.S. Industry average enplanement growth rate of 2.4%
- 2013 YTD total passenger decline of 5.3% lagged A4A U.S. Industry average enplanement growth rate of 1.3%

BWI

- Current Month Activity vs. March 2012 increased 0.7%, but lagged A4A U.S. Industry average enplanement growth rate of 2.4%
- Southwest, US Airways, American, Spirit, JetBlue, and Pinnacle (DL Connection) all experienced increases in passenger activity, which were moderately offset by passenger declines for Delta and United
- BWI's total passengers of 1.9 M surpassed Dulles by 105.7 K passengers and National by 132.4 K passengers
- Southwest had the largest passenger market share with 72.0%; activity increased 0.8% compared to March 2012

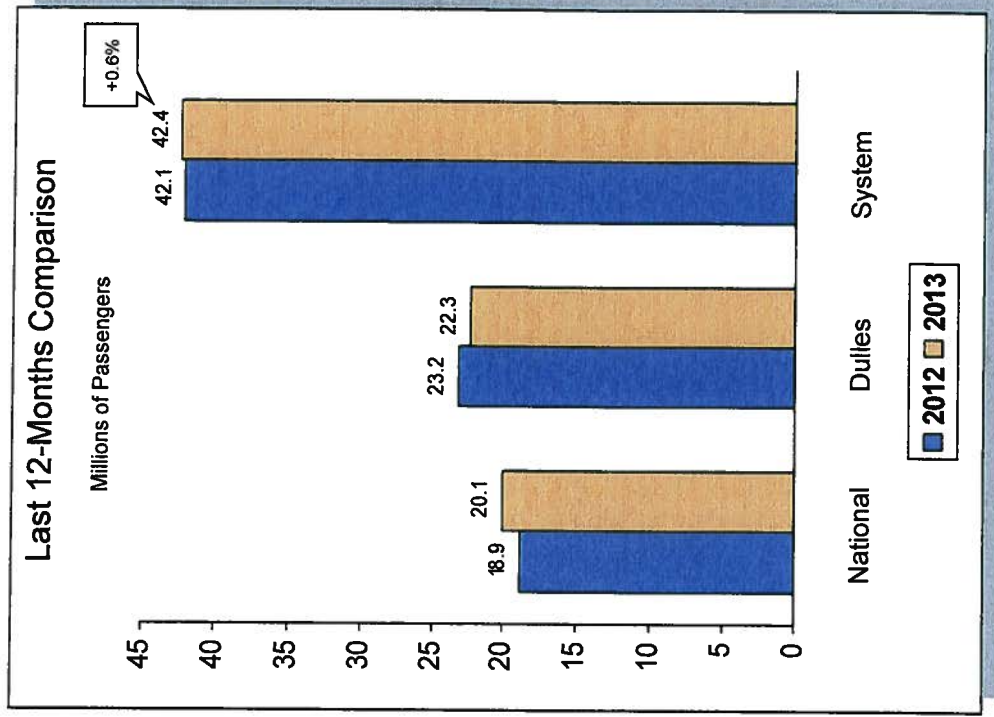
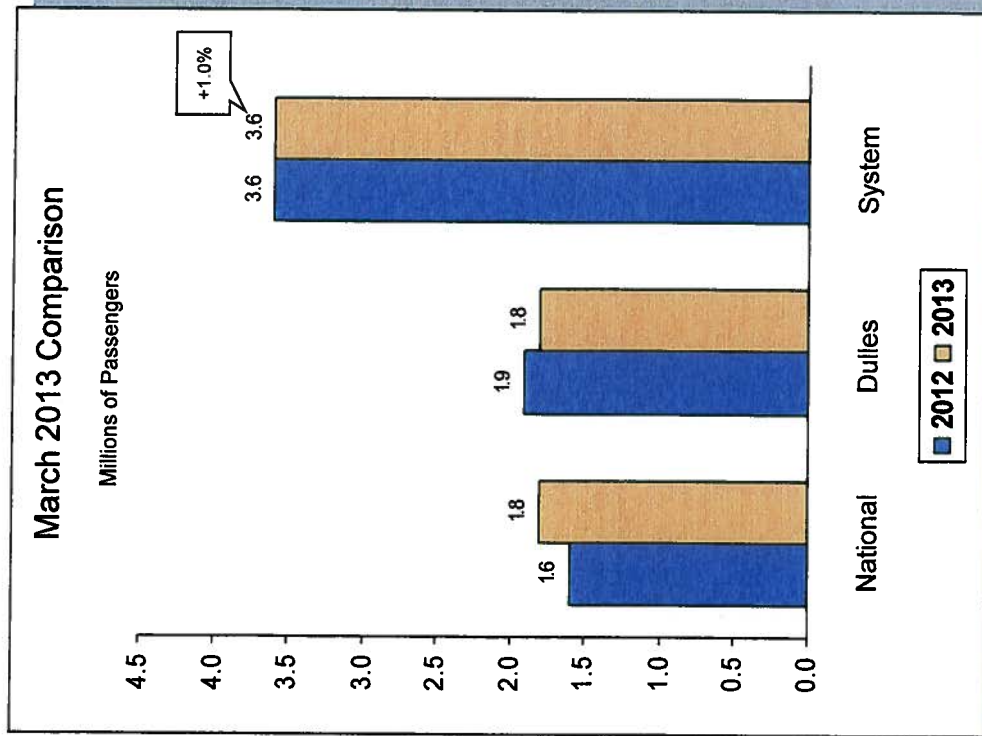

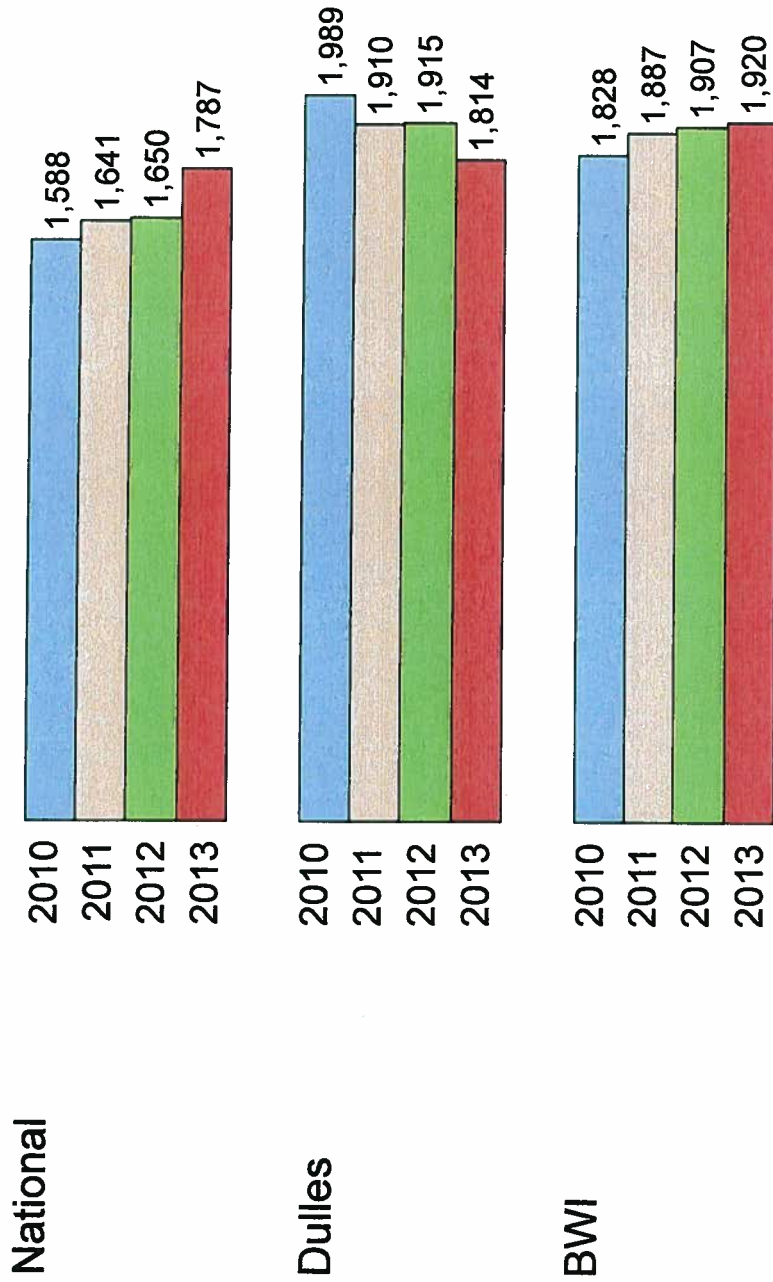

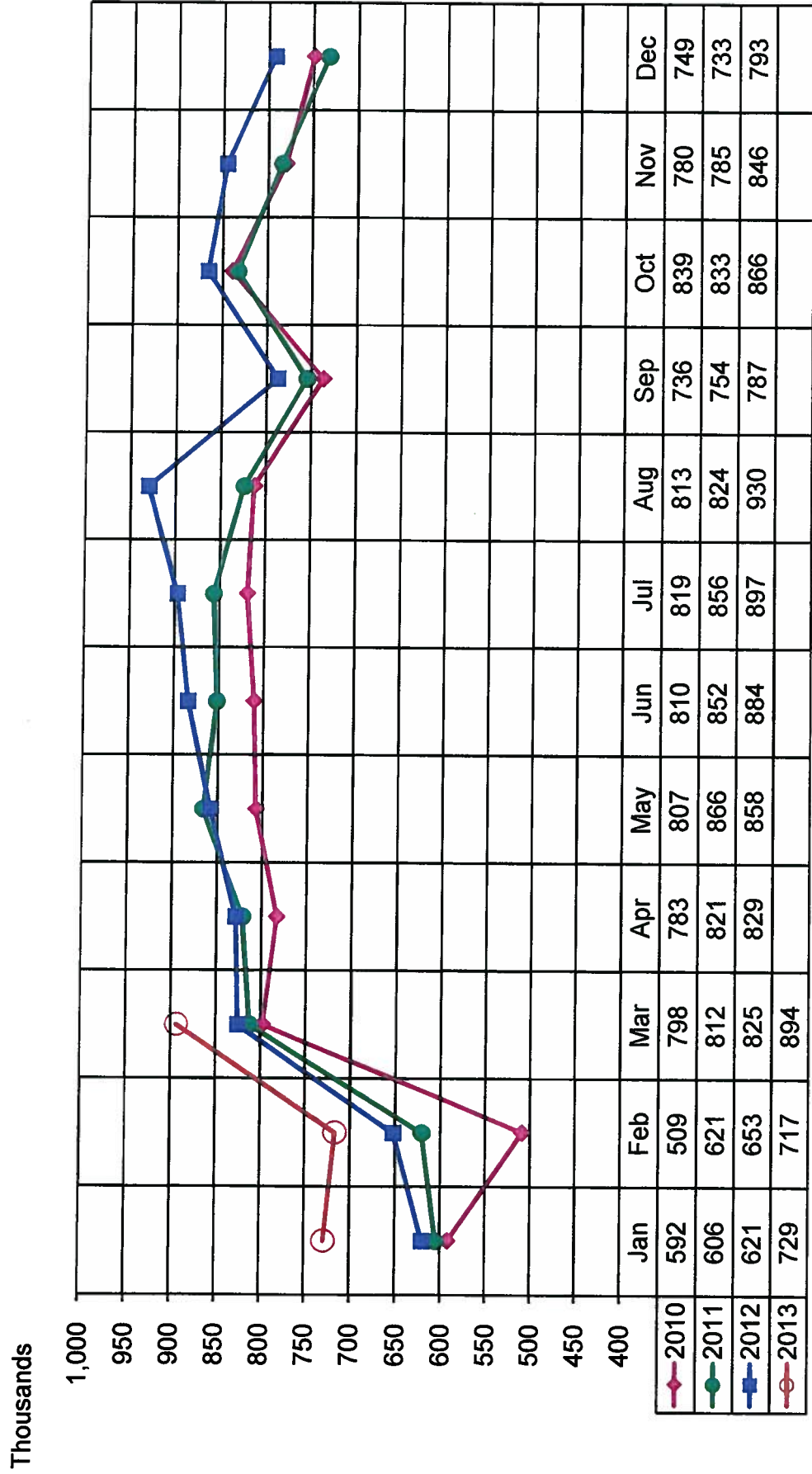

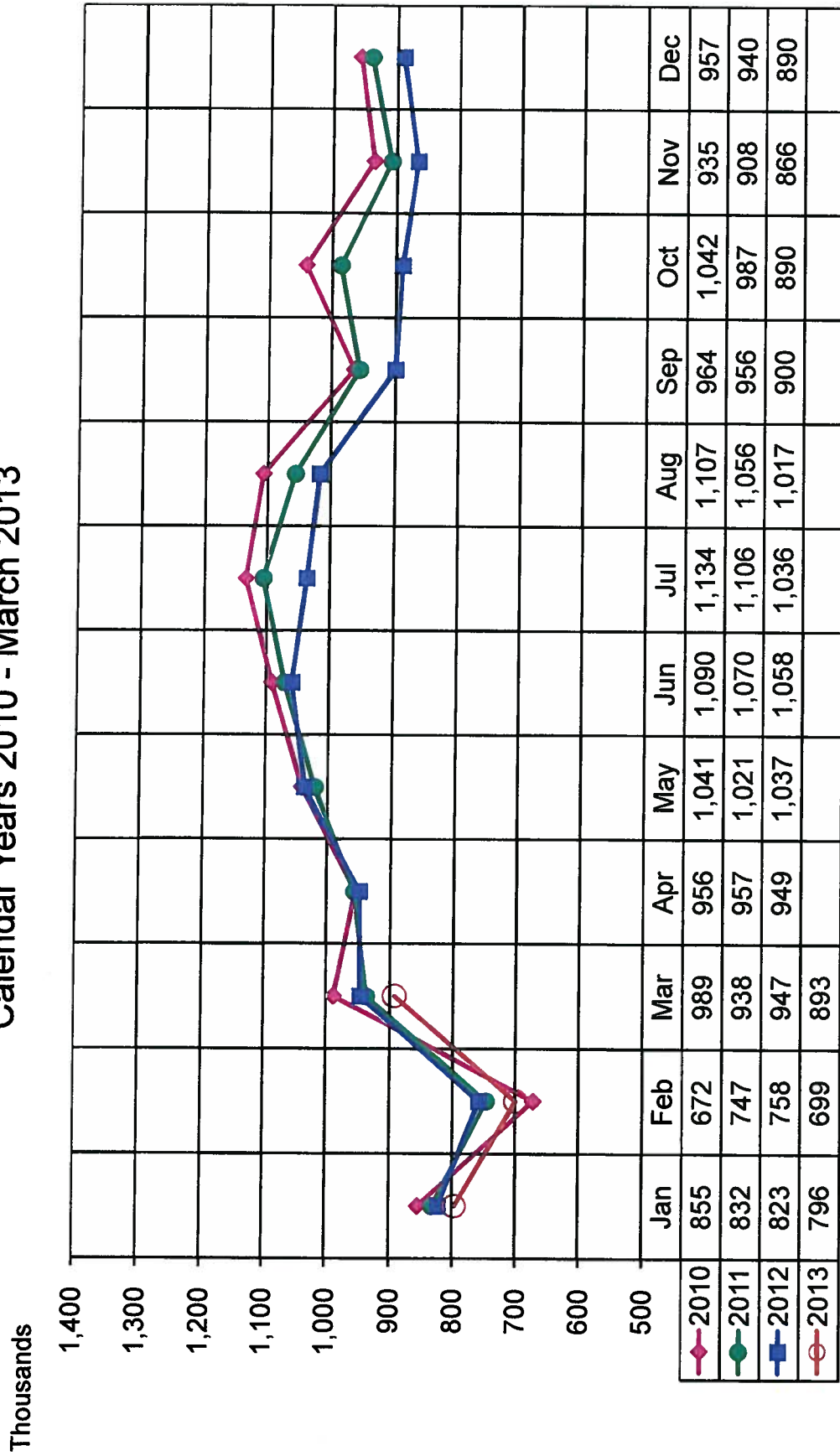
Total Passengers Four Year Comparison of the Month of March (Thousands)
