## Financial Statements

### April 2015

#### Aviation Enterprise Fund – Highlights in Brief

- ➔ Total operating revenues for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for April 2015 were \$65.3 million. Operating revenues increased from March 2015 by \$4.5 million mostly due to increases in rents of \$4.5 million, concessions of \$1.6 million, international arrival fees of \$0.4 million and passenger conveyance fees of \$0.2 million offset by a decrease in landing fees of \$1.5 million and utility sales of \$0.7 million.
- ➔ Year-to-date operating revenues through April 2015 were \$244.1 million, which is an increase of \$15.0 million from 2014 totals. Concessions increased by \$10.5 million, rents increased by \$7.1 million, other revenues increased by \$0.1 million offset by a decrease in landing fees of \$1.8 million, international arrival fees of \$0.4 million, security fees of \$0.3 million, utility sales of \$0.1 million and passenger conveyance fees of \$0.1 million.
- ➔ Total operating expenses for the Aviation Enterprise Fund during the month of April 2015 were \$54.3 million, which is \$3.0 million higher than for March 2015 mostly due to increases in services of \$6.7 million and insurance of \$0.1 million offset by decreases in materials and supplies of \$1.4 million, depreciation and amortization of \$1.2 million, salaries and benefits of \$0.7 million, utilities of \$0.5 million and project expenses of \$0.2 million.
- ➔ Year-to-date operating expenses through April 2015 were \$208.7 million, which is \$0.2 million higher than 2014 primarily due to increases in services of \$3.0 million and depreciation and amortization of \$0.1 million offset by decreases in project expenses of \$0.9 million, insurance of \$0.8 million, salaries and related benefits of \$0.8 million, telecommunications of \$0.3 million, materials and supplies of \$0.2 million and utilities of \$0.1 million.
- ➔ Operating income for the Aviation Enterprise Fund in April 2015 was \$11.0 million compared to operating income of \$9.5 million in March 2015.
- ➔ Year-to-date through April 2015, operating income was \$35.4 million compared to operating income of \$20.7 million through April 2014.
- ➔ In April 2015 there was a net non-operating expenses of \$7.0 million compared to a net non-operating income in March 2015 of \$19.1 million. The positive difference of \$12.0 million is primarily due to a \$12.6 million increase in swaps fair value, a decrease in interest expenses of \$0.3 million offset by a decrease in investment gains of \$0.9 million.
- ➔ Through April 2015, year-to-date net non-operating expenses were \$64.7 million compared to net non-operating expenses of \$86.3 million in 2014. The positive difference of \$21.7 million is mostly comprised of a \$13.0 million increase in swaps fair value, a decrease in interest expense of \$7.6 million and by an increase in the investments gains of \$1.1 million.
- ➔ The capital contributions for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of April 2015 were \$5.5 million compared to \$10.0 million in March 2015. The \$4.5 million decrease is due to a decrease to federal, state and local grants of \$2.4 million and a \$2.1 million change in other capital property contributed. Year-to-date capital contributions were \$27.5 million, a decrease of \$17.3 million from 2014 due to decreases of \$12.0 million in federal, state and local grants and other capital property contributed of \$7.9 million offset by increases to passenger facilities charges of \$2.7 million.
- ➔ There is an increase in net position for the Aviation Enterprise Fund for the month of April 2015 of \$9.5 million compared to an increase of \$0.4 million for the prior month.
- ➔ The year-to-date decrease in net position through April 2015 was \$1.8 million compared to a year-to-date decrease of 20.9 million through April 2014.
- ➔ Accounts receivables delinquent over 30 days, including amounts past due which are in bankruptcy proceedings, had a balance of \$1.8 million as of April 30, 2015, a decrease of 26.1% from March 31, 2015. Delinquent accounts receivables for customer accounts which have a net credit balance are excluded from reported delinquent receivables.
- ➔ Debt service coverage increased from 1.41x in March 2015 to 1.43x in April 2015. Debt service coverage is estimated to be at 1.54x for the full year at December 31, 2015.

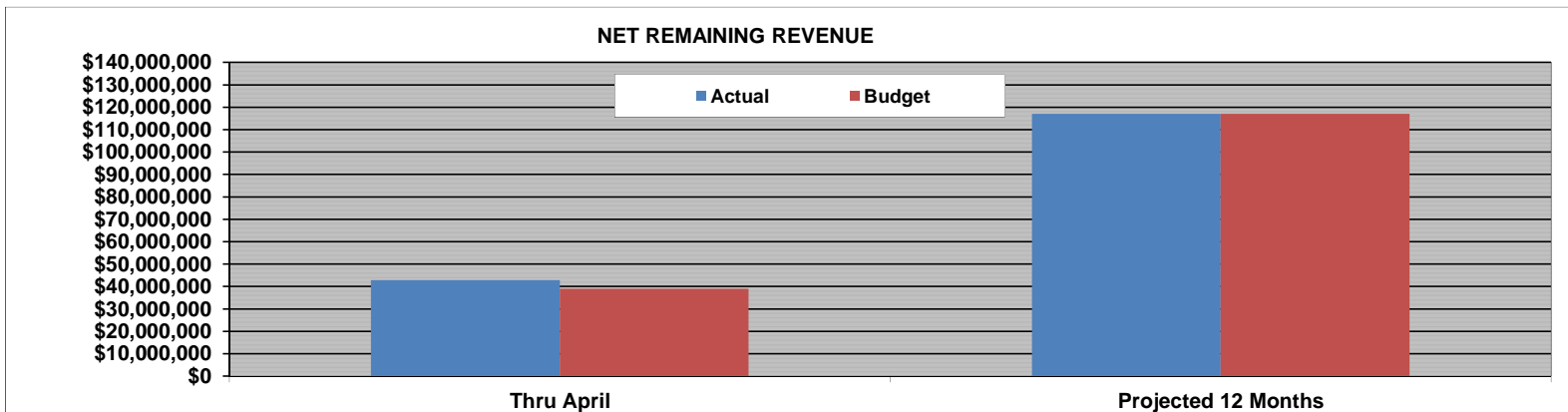

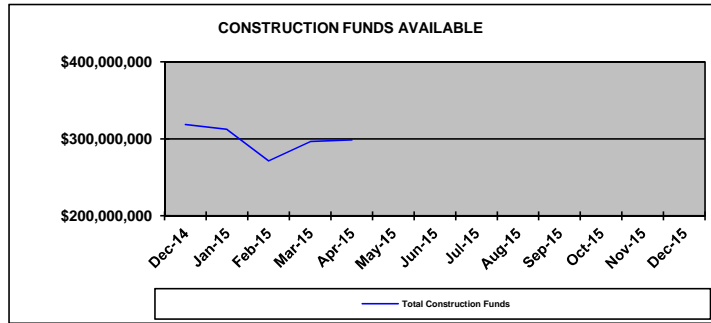
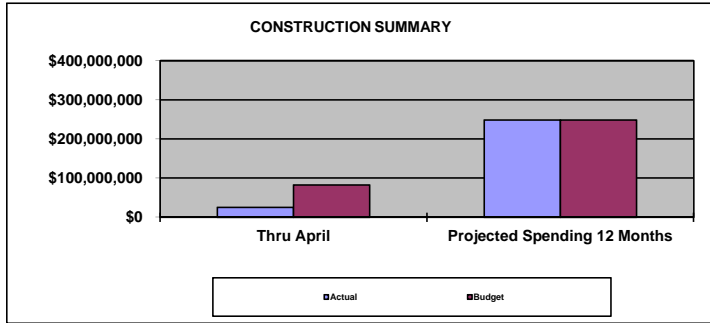

The year-to-date construction spending is at \$25.4 million. The 2015 budget for Capital Construction Program expenditures totals \$248.8 million.

Short-Term Liquidity Forecast: As of April 30, 2015 the Authority had \$298.8 million available in construction funds, which includes \$179.0 million on the shelf in Commercial Paper Series 2 fund. Of the funds on hand as of the end of April, \$69.6 millions were PFC and Grant recycled funds. PFC and Grant recycled funds are available for the same purpose as AMT bond funds.

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during April include the following:

Items of interest with respect to accounts receivable during the month of April include the following:

- The largest decrease in Airline delinquencies is primarily due to payments received for landings from Emirates Airlines for a total amount of \$345,331.
- The largest decrease of Non-Airline delinquencies is attributed to payments received from AMB/AFCO Cargo totaling \$127,743 and Gate Gourmet totaling \$55,978.
- The Government had no change in their delinquency.
- Telecommunications had a decrease of 3.0% which is attributed to payments received from Cox Communications totaling \$1,227.
