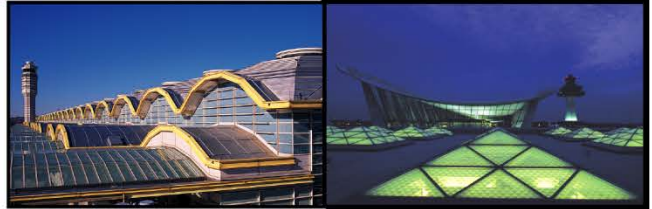

Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport

- Domestic commercial passenger activity increased 7.9% in February 2015 compared to February 2014. Significant activity by carrier follows:

- Transborder passenger traffic increased 1.3% in February 2015 as a result of new service to Nassau by JetBlue in July 2014.
- The combined American + US Airways operations, including its regional affiliates, had the largest commercial passenger market share with 54.0%, a decrease compared to 61.0% in February 2014.

- Domestic commercial passenger activity declined 2.4% in February 2015. Significant activity by carrier follows:

- February 2015 international commercial passenger traffic decreased 4.0%. Significant activity by carrier follows:

- United Airlines, including its regional affiliates, had the largest commercial passenger market share of 62.8%, a decrease compared to 68.5% in February 2014.

Cargo Activity

- For the month of February 2015, total cargo increased 4.6% at Dulles from a year earlier. Domestic cargo increased 1.4% primarily due to increases on United (13.8%) and UPS (13.5%) that offset the decline on FedEx (3.8%).
- International cargo increased 6.1% mainly due to activity increase in United (16.0%), All Nippon (34.7%), Korean Air (76.5%), Saudi Arabian (99.5%), and new service by Air China.

Baltimore-Washington International Airport

- Current month commercial passenger activity increased 3.6% from February 2014.
- BWI commercial passenger activity outpaced activity at Dulles by 147.5k commercial passengers (11.7%), but lagged National by 84.1k commercial passengers (-5.6%).
- Southwest's passenger market share totaled 72.0%, up from 71.0% in February 2014.
- Cargo activity at BWI totaled 8.2k metric tonnes, a 6.7% increase from a year earlier primarily as a result of increases on FedEx (0.6%), and Southwest (15.7%). UPS cargo activity declined (-0.2%).

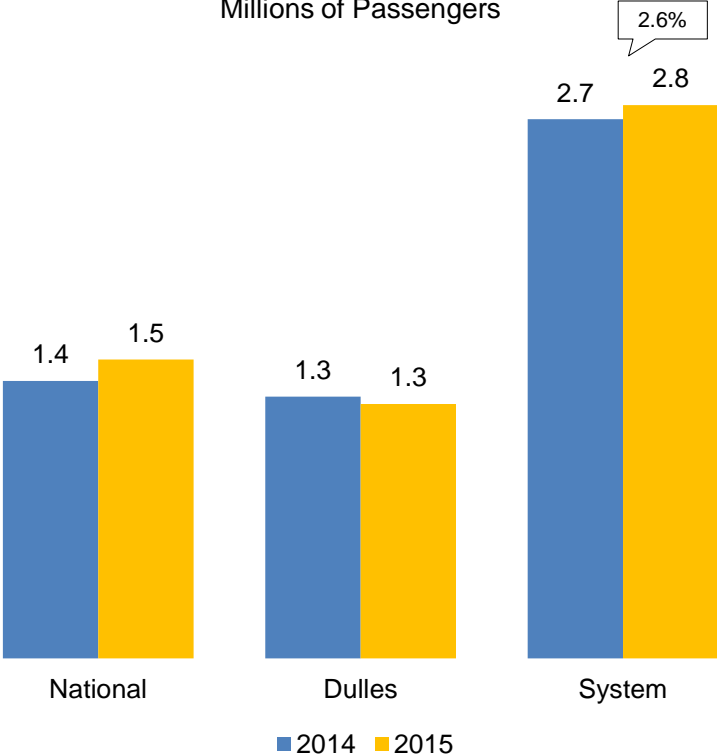

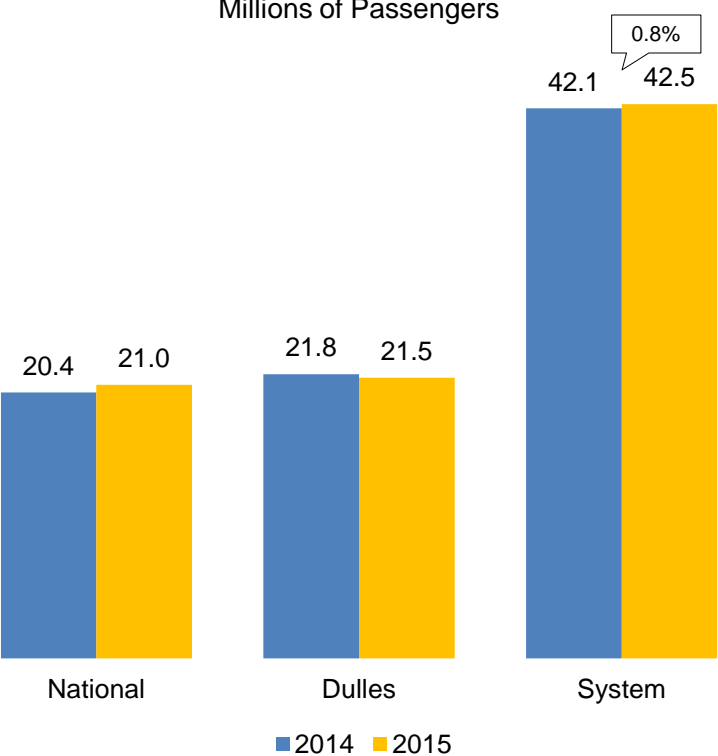
February 2015 Comparison

Last 12-Months Comparison

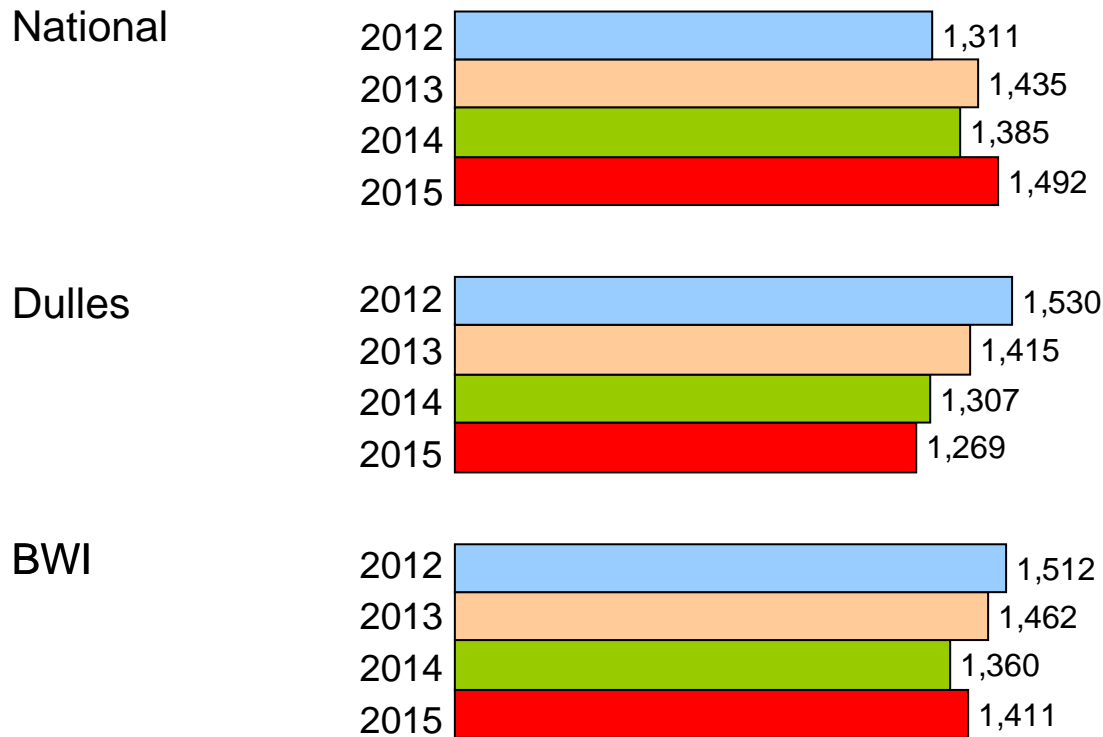

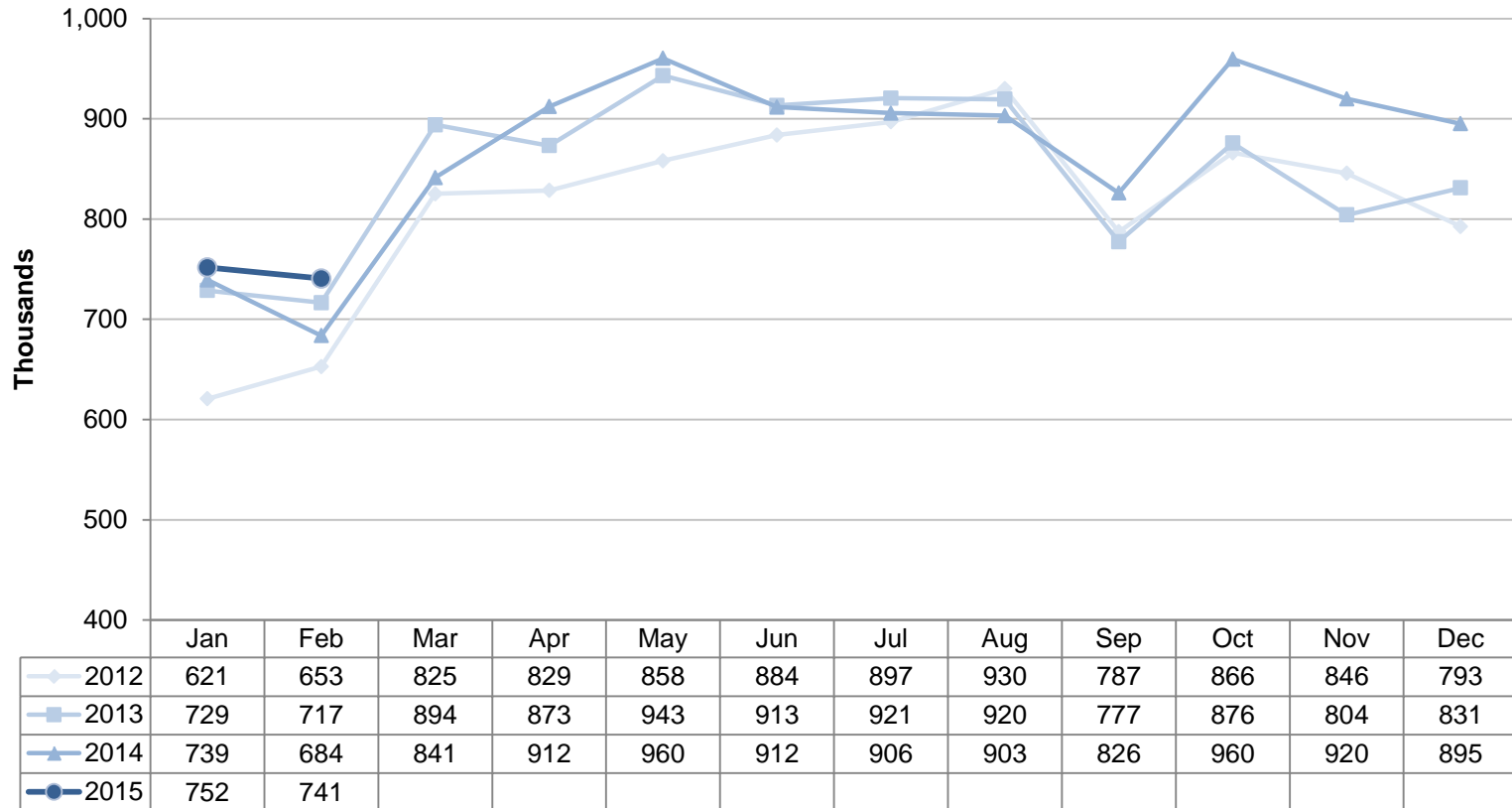

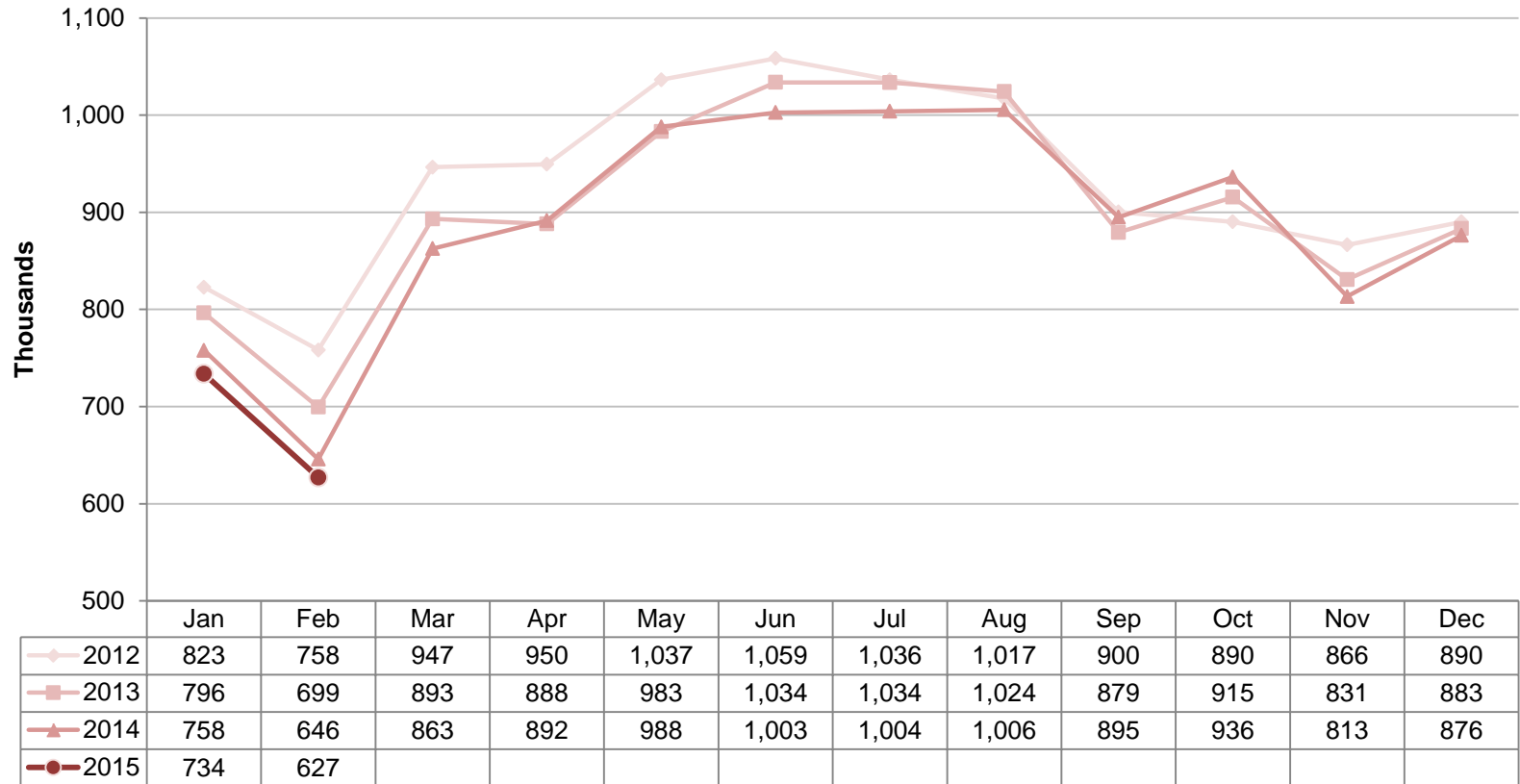
Four Year Comparison of the Month of February (Thousands)
