

## RESOLUTION 21-16

### Selecting a Firm to Provide Unarmed Security Guard Services at Washington Dulles International Airport

WHEREAS, The Transportation Security Administration Regulations and Directives require airport operators to control access to certain parts of their facility and the Airports Authority hires unarmed security guards to assist in compliance with these Regulations and Directives;

WHEREAS, The contract for unarmed security guard services at Washington Dulles International Airport (Dulles International) is scheduled to expire December 31, 2021;

WHEREAS, The Business Administration Committee concurred in the issuance of a Request for Proposals for these services in October 2020;

WHEREAS, A Technical Evaluation Committee reviewed the proposals, and recommended the selection of Securemedy, Incorporated, for a five-year contract with a three-year base term, and one two-year option period, at a total contract value of \$21.6 million over the full five-year term; and

WHEREAS, The Business Administration Committee is satisfied with the results of the competitive procurement process, as presented at its July 21, 2021, meeting; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the President and Chief Executive Officer is authorized and directed to enter into a five-year contract with Securemedy, Incorporated, for the provision of unarmed security guard services at Dulles International, consistent with the terms presented to the Business Administration Committee at its July 21, 2021 meeting.
