

## RESOLUTION 22-2

### Awarding a Contract for Architectural and Engineering Environmental Studies for the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority

WHEREAS, In May 2021, the Strategic Development Committee concurred with the staff's recommendation to issue a Request for Qualifications Information (RFQI) for Architectural and Engineering (A/E) Environmental Studies for the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (Airports Authority);

WHEREAS, in June 2021, the Airports Authority received three (3) responses to the RFQI from three firms; and

WHEREAS the Evaluation Committee performed a technical review of the proposals and concluded that Harris Miller Miller & Hanson (HMMH) was the highest technically rated firm; and

WHEREAS the Contracting Officer evaluated the cost proposal from NMMH and successfully negotiated rates for the proposed services; and

WHEREAS HMMH is a certified Local Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (LDBE) and intends to meet the contract's 70 percent LDBE requirement through self-performance; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the selection of HMMH to provide A/E Environmental Studies for the Airports Authority for a base term of three years, with two, two-year option periods and a total not-to-exceed value of \$14 million over the full seven-year term is approved; and



2. That the President and Chief Executive Officer is authorized to execute a contract with HMMH for the provision of A/E Environmental Studies services for the Airports Authority, consistent with the contract terms and conditions presented to the Strategic Development Committee at its January 19, 2022 Meeting.
