

RESOLUTION NO. 19-17

Authorizing the Award of a Sole Source Contract to Provide Vehicle Movement Area Transponder Units at Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington Dulles International Airports

WHEREAS, Vehicle Movement Area Transponders (VMAT) are part of the Federal Aviation Administration's initiative to reduce the number and severity of movement area incidents which can occur when pilots, air traffic controllers, and surface vehicle operators are unaware of each other's movements;

WHEREAS, L3Harris Technologies, Inc. is the only company approved by the FAA to provide VMAT units;

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (Airports Authority) received an Airports Improvement Program grant from FAA to reimburse up to 75 percent of the cost to purchase and install 75 VMAT units at each Airport;

WHEREAS, The total cost for equipment, installation, and maintenance support for the five-year contract will not exceed \$1,746,064;

WHEREAS, As required by the Airports Authority's Contracting Manual, notice of this sole source contract award has been published on the Airports Authority's website for the required time period and no firm offered a capability statement for this requirement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the President and Chief Executive Officer is authorized to enter into a sole source contract with L3Harris Technologies, Inc. for the purchase,




installation and maintenance support of VMAT units and the equipment used to monitor the location of VMAT unit equipped vehicles at Reagan National and Dulles International.
