

RESOLUTION NO. 20-4

Authorizing the Award of a Contract for
a Computerized Maintenance Management System at Ronald Reagan Washing-
ton National Airport, Washington Dulles International Airport,
and the Dulles Toll Road

WHEREAS, The Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS) is the database used for planning, scheduling, and recording asset maintenance activities;

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (Airports Authority) currently uses two separate, end-of-life CMMSs, which are not capable of full integration with the Airports Authority's Workday platform;

WHEREAS, In September 2018, the Business Administration Committee concurred with staff's recommendation to issue a solicitation for a new CMMS at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (Reagan National), Washington Dulles International Airport (Dulles International), and the Dulles Toll Road (DTR) using the competitively-negotiated "Best Value" procurement method;

WHEREAS, The Department of Supplier Diversity reviewed the solicitation and established a 20 percent Local Disadvantaged Business Enterprise participation requirement;

WHEREAS, The Technical Evaluation Committee concluded that the two highest-rated offerors were qualified and capable of performing the services requested in the Request for Proposals;

WHEREAS, The Contracting Officer separately reviewed the proposed prices, and Electronic Data, Inc., provided the lower price of the two offerors in the competitive range;


WHEREAS, The Business Administration Committee received the results of the evaluation and recommended that the Board of Directors approve the selection of Electronic Data, Inc.; now, therefore, be it



RESOLVED, That the selection of Electronic Data, Inc., for the purchase and implementation of a CMMS at Reagan National, Dulles International, and the DTR for a five-year base term with one five-year option period, at a total value of \$4,719,839.95, is approved; and

2. That the President and Chief Executive Officer is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Electronic Data, Inc., consistent with the terms and conditions presented to the Business Administration Committee at its February 19, 2020 meeting.
