

RESOLUTION NO. 20-15

Authorizing the Award of a Sole Source Contract for the Provision of Airfield Lighting Parts and Components at Washington Dulles International and Ronald Reagan Washington National Airports

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (Airports Authority) is required to maintain ground lighting at both Airports and must meet Federal Aviation Administration standards for airfield lighting;

WHEREAS, ADB Safegate Americas, LLC (ADB Safegate) airfield lights account for approximately 20 percent of the runway fixtures at Washington Dulles International Airport (Dulles International) and 31 percent at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (Reagan National);

WHEREAS, Repair of ADB Safegate fixtures requires manufacturer's parts and accessories, which can only be purchased from ADB Safegate;

WHEREAS, The proposed contract for a one-year base term, with four one-year option periods, will provide warehouse stocked parts and components for frequently purchased ADB Safegate items at both Airports;

WHEREAS, Contracting directly with ADB Safegate will significantly reduce lead times and improve productivity by eliminating individual requisitions each time components are needed;

WHEREAS, The proposed sole source contract is permitted in accordance with Contracting Manual Section 1.4.1(3)(c) Proprietary Equipment and Software;

WHEREAS, As required by the Airports Authority's Contracting Manual, notice of this sole source contract award has been published on the Airports Authority's website for the required time period and no firm offered a capability statement for this requirement; and



WHEREAS, The estimated cost of the proposed contract is approximately \$275,706; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the President and Chief Executive Officer is authorized to enter into a sole source contract with ADB Safegate Americas, LLC for the provision of airfield lighting parts and components at Dulles International and Reagan National.
