

## **RESOLUTION NO. 18-3**

### **Awarding a Contract for Claims Consulting Services for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project**

WHEREAS, In July 2017, staff presented, and the Dulles Corridor Committee concurred with, pre-solicitation terms regarding claims consulting services for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project (Project);

WHEREAS, A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued on August 17, 2017;

WHEREAS, Proposals were received on September 19, 2017 and none of the proposals in the competitive range met the 100 percent Small Business Enterprise participation goal for the solicitation; therefore, the solicitation was canceled;

WHEREAS, A second RFP, including modified proposed contract terms, evaluation criteria, as well as a 20 percent Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goal, was issued on November 8, 2017;

WHEREAS, The Evaluation Committee (EC) reviewed and evaluated the proposals submitted in response to the solicitation; and


WHEREAS, On February 21, 2018, the Dulles Corridor Committee received the results of the EC's evaluation of the submitted proposals and recommended that the Board of Directors approve the selection of Trauner Consulting Services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the contract award to Trauner Consulting Services for construction claims analysis services for Phase 2 of the Project for a one-year base term, with four one-year option periods, at a not-to-exceed amount of \$6.1 million, is approved; and



2. That the President and Chief Executive Officer is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Trauner Consulting Services, consistent with the contract terms presented to the Dulles Corridor Committee on February 21, 2018.
